Slice rug supply list

- Pattern from Shabby Fabrics <u>Slice Rug</u>
 The pattern is necessary for this project as it includes the layout diagram and cutting diagram.
- 2. 50 yds of 2 1/4" strip batting Bosal roll works best.
- 3. 31 2 1/2" strips from a jelly roll or your stash of fabric. 29 strips for the rug and 2 for the binding.
- 4. A size 12-16 jeans, microtex or topstitch needle.
- 5. A large spool of quality thread Aurifil or Mettler
- 6. A sturdy sewing machine with a walking foot or dual feed works best! The machine must be able to do a zigzag through multiple layers of fabric and batting.

- 2. The Gypsy Quilter Jelly Roll tube maker
- 3. Wonder clips
