

If you cut A frames:

- Choose a frame fabric for each block.
- Sew a 14-1/2" piece to each side of each block. Press toward the frame.
- Sew a 18-1/2" piece to the top and bottom of each block. Press toward the frame.
- Each block should measure 18-1/2" x 18-1/2".

If you cut B frames:

- Choose a frame fabric for each block.
- Sew a 14-1/2" piece to each side of each block. Press toward the frame.
- Trim the ends of the piece just added to be even with the block.
- Sew a 20-1/2" piece to the top and bottom of each block. Press toward the frame.
- Trim all blocks to measure 18-1/2" x 18-1/2".

Sew into rows. Press rows 1 and 3 to the left; 2 and 4 to the right. Sew rows together.

Backing:

Cut the 3-1/2 yard piece in half. Trim the selvages. Sew the long edges together using a 1/2" seam. Press open.

(12)Fat quarters for frames

5/8 yd print for binding

Optional backing: 3.5 yards for a horizontal seam.

If your blocks are all close to 14-1/2" then follow A cutting. If they are smaller or vary in size follow B.

A. From each fat quarter cut
(2) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2"
(2) 2-1/2" x 18-1/2"

B. From each fat quarter cut
(2) 3-1/2" x 14-1/2"
(2) 3-1/2" x 20-1/2"
