

## If you cut A frames:

- Choose a frame fabric for each block.
- Sew a 14-1/2" piece to each side of each block. Press toward the frame.
- Sew a 18-1/2" piece to the top and bottom of each block. Press toward the frame.
- Each block should measure $18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## If you cut B frames:

- Choose a frame fabric for each block.
- Sew a 14-1/2" piece to each side of each block. Press toward the frame.
- Trim the ends of the piece just added to be even with the block.
- Sew a 20-1/2" piece to the top and bottom of each block. Press toward the frame.
- Trim all blocks to measure $18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

Sew into rows. Press rows 1 and 3 to the left; 2 and 4 to the right. Sew rows together.

## Backing:

Cut the $3-1 / 2$ yard piece in half. Trim the selvages. Sew the long edges together using a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Press open.

5/8 yd print for binding
Optional backing: 3.5 yards for a horizontal seam.

If your blocks are all close to $14-1 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ then follow A cutting. If they are smaller or vary in size follow $B$.
A. From each fat quarter cut
(2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
B. From each fat quarter cut
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


Tula 2 Quilt KT5122
$100^{\prime \prime} \times 100^{\prime \prime}$
12 blocks plus 1 extra block
5 yds background
1-7/8 yd inner border and binding
1-1/8 yard outer border
$1 / 2$ yd star centers
$1 / 2$ yd star points
Follow directions for Tilda 1.
$7-1 / 2$ yd backing or 3 yard wide backing
