## RETROSPECTIVE & LESSONS LEARNT FOR WIDER RHS PRAYS

- handout prepared and shared in advance (one week) of the meeting to prepare everyone and encourage use in personal quiet time outside of meeting.
- 2 facilitators prayer session plus anchor/convener = 3 people. Team work (joint ownership) helped to make planning effective & efficient.
- 7 to 10 minutes max per prayer slot (average was 7.5 minutes with 7 prayer points).
  - official start time was 9pm though portal link formally opened by 8.45pm with worship playing. Reminders sent out every 20 minutes from 8pm.

- started promptly and disciplined with ensuring did not go past 9.45pm by closing then leaving the floor open for further discussions, feedback, strategising and sharing.

 As we build capacity and momentum spread the light for 2nd Saturday of the month to open up officially to the wider Tribe (RHS PRAYS) and whilst clans organise themselves as cell units 4th Saturday of the month. Individuals loved the intimacy that comes with worshipping, support & sharing personal experiences with transparency within a clan. Hence, clan providing safe space & love cluster as a smaller unit.

- with the leading of the Holy Spirit within clans (cell units) some sessions that fall on the 4th Saturday can be purely soaking up in worship and no other activity.
  - to look into utilising an anonymous app for sensitive personal prayer requests.
- to confirm if each set has a name as pioneer set(s) do not have but '03 set prayerfully praying for inspiration from the Holy Spirit for a name
