## Safety Instructions

#### CAUTION READ BEFORE USE

- Do not modify or tamper with the product.
- Do not block intake or exhaust vents.
  - Do not insert objects into any opening.
- Do not operate without a filter installed.
- Always unplug before moving,
- cleaning, or servicing.
- Supervise use around children or pets.

- Do not use with extension cords or power strips.
- Plug the unit directly into a wall outlet.
- Do not touch plug or unit with wet hands.
- Use indoors only in dry environments.
- If the cord is damaged, do not use.

## Safety Instructions

#### CAUTION READ BEFORE USE

- Place on a flat, stable surface at least6 inches from walls or furniture.
- Do not cover the unit or place near curtains, bedding, or paper products.
- Avoid placing on soft or uneven surfaces like beds or sofas.
- Do not use near gas appliances, open flames, or in industrial settings.

- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the unit. opening unit may void warranty
- This product contains no userserviceable parts.
- Contact Canopy Support if the unit malfunctions or is damaged.
- Opening the unit may void your warranty.

## How it Works

Air enters through the sides of the unit and passes through a multi-stage filtration system that helps captures airborne particles.

Depending on the devices position, clean air is released upward or sideways.

A built-in aroma puck diffuses Canopy's signature scents, turning clean air into a full-sensory experience.


A light sensor auto-adjusts fan speed between day and night, while a soft backlight adds a calming, sleep-friendly glow.

Always keep out of reach of young children when not in use.


# Your Air Purifier is made up of these parts:




## Setup & Placement

- 1 Choose a spot at least 6" from walls or furniture.
- 2 Place on a firm, flat surface near a power outlet. The Air Purifier can be positioned flat or upright.
- 3 Plug in the included power adapter

- 4 Add 10-15 drops of essential oil to aroma puck & place in aroma compartment.
- 5 Tap the power button to turn on.



## Controls



- Power Button
  - Hold for 3s: Activate/
    Deactivate Child Lock
- Night Light

Cycle between Red White and Off Hold to dim/brighten

Air Quality Indicator

Green: Good (PM2.5  $\leq$  35)

Orange: Moderate (PM36-85)

Red: Poor (PM86+)

Filter Reset

Hold for 3s to Reset

Fan Speed Controls

Tap each number to select speed

Sleep-safe auto mode adjusts speeds throughout the day based on air quality - Keeps constant throughout the night to avoid disturbances

## Flexible Placement & Power

Whether it's in a nursery, bedroom, or tucked into a corner, The Canopy Air Purifier keeps your air fresh and your space feeling clean without taking up space.

#### Face-Up (Horizontal)

Best for low shelves, under-bed setups, or minimalist surfaces


### **Upright (Vertical)**

Ideal for nightstands, dressers, or corners



#### **One Port Power**

Power both your Canopy Air Purifier and Humidifier from the same outlet using the built-in USB-C output.



#### How to:

- 1. Plug the air purifier into a standard wall outlet using the included adapter.
- 2. Connect the purifier's USB-C OUT to the humidifier's USB-C IN using a compatible cable.
- 3. Both devices will power on through a single outlet with no bulky power strips needed.



### Maintenance





- Unplug the unit.
- Remove the faceplate (dishwasher safe – top rack only).

- Wipe interior and fan vents with a damp cloth.
- Clean aroma area with a dry cloth.

DO NOT SUBMERGE OR SPRAY THE UNIT DIRECTLY.

DO NOT PLACE THE BODY OR FILTER IN THE DISHWASHER.


# Diffusing Aromas

 Add 10-15 drops of Canopy aroma oil onto the felt aroma puck.



 Replace puck every 1–2 weeks depending on frequency of use.





# Filter Replacement


### 1. Turn Off and Unplug

Ensure the Air
Purifier is turned off
and unplugged from
the electrical outlet.




### 2. Open Unit

Remove the Faceplate and pull slider button to release filter.



#### 3. Remove Used Filter


Carefully remove the used filter. Seal it in a disposable bag and follow your local guidelines for safe disposal.



# Filter Replacement

### 4. Replace Filter


Place new Filter into Faceplate, ensuring it's properly seated.



### 5. Replace Faceplate

Replace Faceplate. Plug in.

Reset Filter Light: Hold Filter Reset Button for 3 Seconds.



## FAQ

Q: How quiet is the Air Purifier?

A: Under 25 dB on low-perfect for nurseries, bedrooms, and nighttime use.

Q: Can I turn off the nightlight completely?

A: Yes. Tap the light button until it cycles to OFF.

Q: Will the nightlight shut off after a certain amount of time?

A: No. To turn it off, tap the light button until it reaches OFF mode.

Q: How often should I replace the Air Purifier Filter?

A: For optimal performance, we recommend replacing your Canopy Air Purifier filter every 6 months (approximately 720 hours of use). This interval is based on average home air quality and daily use.

However, replacement timing may vary depending on your environment:

Your device's filter indicator light will illuminate when it's time for a change. After replacing the filter, press and hold the reset button for 3 seconds to restart the timer.

Q: Where can I buy replacement filters or aroma felt pucks?

A: Visit getcanopy.co

Q: Can I vacuum the filter instead of replacing it?

A: No. The Canopy Air Purifier uses a multi-stage filter designed to capture fine particles – it's not meant to be cleaned or reused. Vacuuming or rinsing can damage the delicate filtration layers – reducing performance and potentially releasing trapped particles back into the air.

Q: What room size is the Canopy Air Purifier best for?

A: The Canopy Air Purifier is optimized for small to medium-sized rooms, like bedrooms, nurseries, and home offices.
