

**Psalm 96A**  
**O Sing a New Song**

1. O sing a new song to the LORD; All earth  
sing to the LORD.

Sing to the LORD, and bless His name; “He  
saves!” each day proclaim.  
His glory to all nations show;  
His deeds let peoples know.

2. The LORD is great, great praise He’s due.  
He’s feared above all gods.  
For peoples’ gods mere idols are;  
The LORD the heavens made.  
Before Him honor, majesty,  
And strength and splendor dwell.

3. O families of earth, ascribe  
All glory to the LORD.  
All strength ascribe unto the Lord;  
Give glory due His name.  
Come to the LORD, into His courts,  
And bring an offering.

**Psalm 57B**  
**O Be Exalted High, O God**

1. O be exalted high, O God;  
Above the heavens stand;  
And let Your glory be above  
All earth, both sea and land.

2. They spread a net to catch my feet;  
My soul was bowed with dread.  
Although they dug a pit for me,  
They fell in it instead.

3. My heart is firm, my heart is firm,  
O God, I’ll praise with song.  
My glory wake! Wake harp and lyre!  
My song will wake the dawn.

4. And I will offer thanks to You  
Among the peoples, Lord;  
And I among the nations will  
With song my praise sound forth.

5. Because Your cov’nant love is great,  
It reaches heaven high;  
And Your unfailing faithfulness  
Extends up to the sky.

6. O be exalted high, O God!  
Above the heavens stand,  
And let Your glory be above  
All earth, both sea and land.

**Psalm 19A**  
**The Skies Above**

1. The skies above declare the glory of our  
God;  
The firmament displays His handiwork  
abroad.  
From day to day they pour out speech;  
Their knowledge every night they teach.

2. Although they do not speak, and utter  
not a word,  
Though they no language use, or voice  
that can be heard,  
Their message to the world they send,  
Their word to earth’s remotest end.

3. In heav’n He pitched a tent; He gave the  
sun its place.  
And with an athlete’s joy, it thrills to run  
its race.  
It rises, glorious, like a groom  
When he emerges from his room.

4. The heavens are its course—at one end  
it will rise  
Till to the other end it runs across the skies;

Its rays extend on every side,  
And nothing from its heat can hide.

**Psalm 72F**

**Now Blessed Be the LORD Our God (Book  
Two Doxology)**

1. Now blessed be the LORD our God,  
The God of Israel;  
For He alone does wondrous works,  
In glory that excel.

2. And blessed be His glorious name,  
To all eternity.  
The whole earth let His glory fill;  
Amen, so let it be.

**Psalm 8C**

**O LORD, Our Lord**

1. O LORD, our Lord, in all the earth  
How glorious is Your name!  
For You have set above the heav'ns  
Your glory and Your fame.

2. From infants' and from children's lips  
You ordered praise to sound  
To silence all Your enemies,  
The wicked to confound.

3. When I regard the heav'ns You made,

I see the moon and shining stars  
Which You have set in place.

4. I ask myself, "What then is man  
That You should give him thought—  
The son of man, that You to him  
Such gracious care have brought?"

5. Yet You created him to be  
Just less than one divine;

And made his glory shine.

6. You made him ruler of the works  
Created by Your hand;  
You placed all things beneath his feet  
To be in his command:

7. All sheep and oxen, birds and fish,  
All beasts both wild and tame.  
O LORD, our Lord, in all the earth  
How glorious is Your name!

**Psalm 66A**

**O All the Earth**

**Psalm 47A**  
**All Nations, Clap Your Hands**

1. All nations, clap your hands for joy;  
To God lift shouts and sing!

And He it is who nations all  
Subdues beneath our feet.

The shields of earth belong to Him;  
Exalted high is God.

**Psalm 138B**

2. For You have magnified Your word,  
So far above Your name adored.

You strengthened me and made me bold.

3. All kings of earth will thank You, LORD;  
They'll sing when they have heard Your  
word.

The LORD's ways they will celebrate;  
The glory of the LORD is great.

4. The LORD, although exalted high,  
On lowly ones will keep His eye;  
But those who proud and haughty are,  
He knows them only from afar.

5. Through trouble though my pathway be,  
My life You will preserve for me;  
With outstretched hand You will oppose  
The wrath and anger of my foes.

6. Your right hand, LORD, will set me free  
And work out what pertains to me.  
Your love, O LORD, forever stands;  
Leave not the works done by Your hands.

**Psalm 93B**  
**The LORD Is Crowned as King**

1. The LORD is crowned as King  
He's clothed with greatness.  
The LORD has clothed Himself,  
He's dressed with power.  
The world is firmly set,  
And it will not be moved.  
Your throne is set of old;  
You are eternal.

2. The floods have lifted, LORD,  
The floods lift their voice.  
The floods lift up their waves,

The LORD on high is strong,  
More than the ocean's waves.  
Your word is true; O LORD,  
Your house is holy.

## Psalm 104A

### My Soul, Bless the LORD!

1. My soul, bless the LORD!  
LORD God, You are great,  
With honor arrayed, majestic in state!  
You cover Yourself with a garment of light  
And stretch out the sky  
as a curtain by night.

2. The beams of Your courts in waters You  
laid;  
On wings of the wind  
Your pathway You made.  
The clouds are Your chariot;  
the winds do Your will;  
The flames and the lightnings  
Your pleasure fulfill.

3. You set up the earth on foundations  
sure,  
That always it should unshaken endure.  
Deep seas like a garment about it You cast;  
The waters stood high;  
over mountains they passed.

4. But at Your rebuke the high waters fled;  
Your thunder they heard  
and from there they sped.  
The mountains arose, and the valleys sank  
low,  
And went to the place  
You ordained them to go.

## Psalm 104B

1. By limits You set, the waters are bound,

10 You make springs gush forth

4. So man brings forth food by working the  
ground,  
And wine makes his heart  
with gladness abound.  
To make his face shine he extracts  
fragrant oil,  
And finds bread that strengthens  
his heart for his toil.

## Psalm 104C

### The Trees of the LORD

1. The trees of the LORD  
are provided with water,  
The cedars of Lebanon  
planted by Him.  
The birds build their nests there,  
the storks choose the fir trees.  
Wild goats climb high mountains  
where rock badgers hide.  
The moon He created  
to mark off the seasons;  
The sun knows the time  
for its setting each night.

2. When You bring the darkness,  
and night follows daytime,  
The beasts of the forest  
all come out to prowl.  
The young lions roar as for prey  
they go searching,  
Depending on God  
to provide them with food.  
But when the sun rises  
they go into hiding,  
While man goes to work  
until evening again.

3. Your works, LORD, are many,  
created in wisdom;  
The whole earth is filled with  
the things You have made.  
Consider the ocean, so vast,  
filled with creatures:  
The large and the tiny—  
too many to count.  
The ships sail upon it,  
Leviathan lives there;  
You made it to play  
in the depths of the sea.

**Psalm 104D**  
**How Many Works, LORD**

1. How many works, LORD,  
in wisdom You've made.  
How fully on earth,  
Your wealth is displayed.  
Consider the ocean,  
how great and how wide,  
Where small and great creatures  
unnumbered abide.

2. Where ships sail the deep  
and sea monsters play;  
These all look to You  
to give food each day.  
Whatever You give them

they gather for food;  
When Your hand You open  
You fill them with good.

3. When You hide Your face,  
bewildered they yearn.  
When You take their breath,  
to dust they return.  
When You send Your Spirit,  
created are they.  
The face of the ground  
You renew every day.

**Psalm 104E**  
**Forevermore May the LORD's Glory Stand**

1. Forevermore may  
the LORD's glory stand;  
The LORD will enjoy  
the works of His hand.  
He looks at the earth  
and it trembles in fear;  
He touches the mountains,  
the smoke then appears.

2. As long as I live, the LORD  
I will praise;  
To God I will sing  
throughout all my days.  
May my meditation be  
pleasing to Him;  
My heart in the LORD  
then with gladness will brim.

3. Consumed from the earth  
let sinners then be;  
The wicked in life  
no more let us see.  
And now, O my soul, blessing give  
to the LORD!  
Let glad hallelujahs ring;  
O praise the LORD!

**Psalm 108C**  
**With Steadfast Heart, O God**

1. With steadfast heart, O God,  
My soul will sing Your praise.  
Awaken lyre, awaken harp;  
I'll wake the dawn's first rays.
2. I will give thanks to You,  
Among the peoples, LORD,  
Among the nations I will sing  
Your praise to all the world.
3. Your steadfast love is great,
