On to more BIG news — there are now 157 students enrolled in our school! I can't believe how much we've grown! We have 60 boys and 97 girls in grades K-6. The predominance of girls is on purpose. We really want to make sure that the "girl child" of Sierra Leone gets an education. Our students are some of the kids we have in our care, but most of them are children from impoverished communities in the vicinity of the Children's Center. We educate the children free of charge, and provide them with lunch (and sometimes breakfast).

Of course, this education isn't really "free," and that's where you come in. We're amazed that our school has grown so much, and are excited that the children are getting an education. You've made that possible! But we completely rely on you for our needs, and those needs grow as we help more children. Please consider giving as generously as you can.
