This classic german-style Hefe has those standard banana and clove notes plus some chamomile to help you relax. Hefeweizens are some of Tom's favorite beers, easy to drink yet with enough flavor to make you sit back and savor each sip.

GROOVING ON 'EM

DAVID STANICH, CALGARY, AB

An American wheat ale, the standard malty mouthfeel & sweetness are toned down with a citric acid kick from

the grapefruit. There is a very, *very* slight hop to the beer, which helps round-out the overall taste profile. Wheat ales typically have a touch more weight to them, but this has a pleasant lightness to it, likely to due with the addition of the grapefruit.

This beer, much like its namesake, is small in stature but memorable in flavor. Easy drinking, light and crisp with bright hop flavors of ripe fruits, citrus and pineapple, it finishes with a cracker-like maltiness.
