



Our theme this month is "Town & Country", and we are featuring two breweries with three beers each. Our "Town" beers are from Town Square, and our "Country" beers were selected from Apex Brewing.

Town Square (2919 Ellwood Dr SW Edmonton) has been a huge part of the craft beer scene here at Sandy Lane. They are one of only three breweries to have a full cooler door dedicated to their beers alone (the others being Sea Change and SYC). Town Square isn't afraid to color outside the lines, with fresh takes like White Wedding (with actual wedding cake tossed into the brew) and Beets by Sinden (a sour made with beets) while still delivering tried & tested recipes for outstanding "mainstream" brews.

Apex Brewing exists "somewhere west of Edmonton" nestled in the trees north of the Yellowhead. Their recent can design changes have really helped stepped the brand up visually, and helps consumers realize that they've allowed their surroundings to infuse and direct their recipes and beer style choices.

## **RUSHING WATERS**

#### APEX BREWING, YELLOWHEAD COUNTY

This is a classic Bohemian brew: chewy maltiness with crisp and clean bite. Multiple additions of Czech Saaz hops during the extended lagering time allows for the bready-maltiness to blend seamlessly with more herbal hop. Easily one of the more crushable beers in this pack.

## **AVALANCHE AVENGER**

#### TOWN SQUARE, EDMONTON

Created this winter as a fundraising beer for the Canadian Ski Patrol - Edmonton Zone, Avalanche Avenger is what it advertises itself as: a juicy pale ale. This brew leans back to what pales *used* to be before the arms-race began to see how much hops you could infuse into your beers. Tropical notes highlight the beer, not dominate it, while the subtle hops hover around the edges.

## SQUARE MILE IMPERIAL SOUR

## TOWN SQUARE, EDMONTON

A collaboration with 9 Mile Legacy (Saskatoon, SK), this sour is nothing to shake a stick at! Coming in at a hefty 8%, the acidity of the beer actually seems to be tempered down by the high octane! Be prepared when you crack this can... this isn't your granny's sour, kiddo!

## PALE HORSEMAN
