# WHAT'S IN THE BOX?

### 4 DECKS OF GAME CARDS

In the box, you'll find 4 decks of game cards: 1 for each round of Santa VS Jesus.

#### Do not shuffle these cards!

The cards come in a specific order for gameplay.

If you have shuffled them, jump to our troubleshooting section at the end to learn how to put them back in the correct order.



### **BELIEVER & CHARACTER CARDS**

In the middle of the box, you'll find 28 Believer Cards and 16 Character Cards.





For centuries, people have wondered, "Who rules Christmas? Santa or Jesus?" Well, it's time to decide once and for all. In this epic battle, Santa and Jesus go head-to-head to win the most believers and, ultimately, to rule Christmas.

### OBJECTIVE

It's simple. The team with the most Believer Cards at the end of the game wins.

### SET UP

#### **1. SPLIT INTO TEAMS**

Divide the players into two teams: Team Jesus and Team Santa. So, if there are 7 players, 3 players would be Team Jesus and 4 players would be Team Santa.

#### 2. SPLIT THE BELIEVER CARDS

Take the 28 double-sided Believer Cards. One side are Team Santa Believers, the other Team Jesus Believers. Give 14 Believer Cards to each team.

#### **3. CHOOSE CHARACTERS**

There are 8 Character Cards for each team. Hand these out now and place them face up on the table. Each player must now select a Character Card to represent them in the game. Once every player has selected a Character, keep the remaining Character Cards nearby.

Starting now, all players must call each other by their Character names, not their real names.

### Call any player by their real name, and your team lose 1 Believer Card.

For example, if I select The Virgin Mary Character Card, all players must refer to me as "Virgin Mary". If any player calls me by my real name, that player's team must give **1 Believer Card** to their rival team.

#### 3. ICONS

To speed things along, we've added icons on the reverse of the Story Cards.



These should be self-explanatory, but if you get lost visit our **TROUBLESHOOTING** section on your right and have a look at what each icon means.

#### **4. KEEPING ORGANIZED**

Always return cards to the bottom of the pile after use. Play passes back and forth between the teams, so keep an eye on the cards.

## THERE IS SOMETHING WRONG WITH THE CARD ORDER!

It's cool, don't panic. On the front of each card, you'll notice two tiny numbers on the bottom right hand side. The first number refers to the game number (in our example game 1), and the second is the number of the card (in our

There are 50 cards in each pack. Once they are back in order, you are ready to play!

#### I'M LOST!

Make sure your cards are in the right order, then follow the instructions on each card. If you are stuck on a certain card, read the card's instructions slowly and clearly, doing each action as it is described on the card.

#### **4. READY THE TIMER**

Place one phone (or stopwatch) in the center of the table, ready for use.

#### **5. READY THE CARDS**

Take the pack of cards labeled "GAME 1" and place it in the center of the table. Remember not to shuffle the cards :)

Santa VS Jesus is simple! Just follow the instructions on every card. Both teams will take turns to compete in a series of challenges. Each challenge normally consists of 3 cards: **a Story Card, a Challenge Card, and an Answer Card.**
