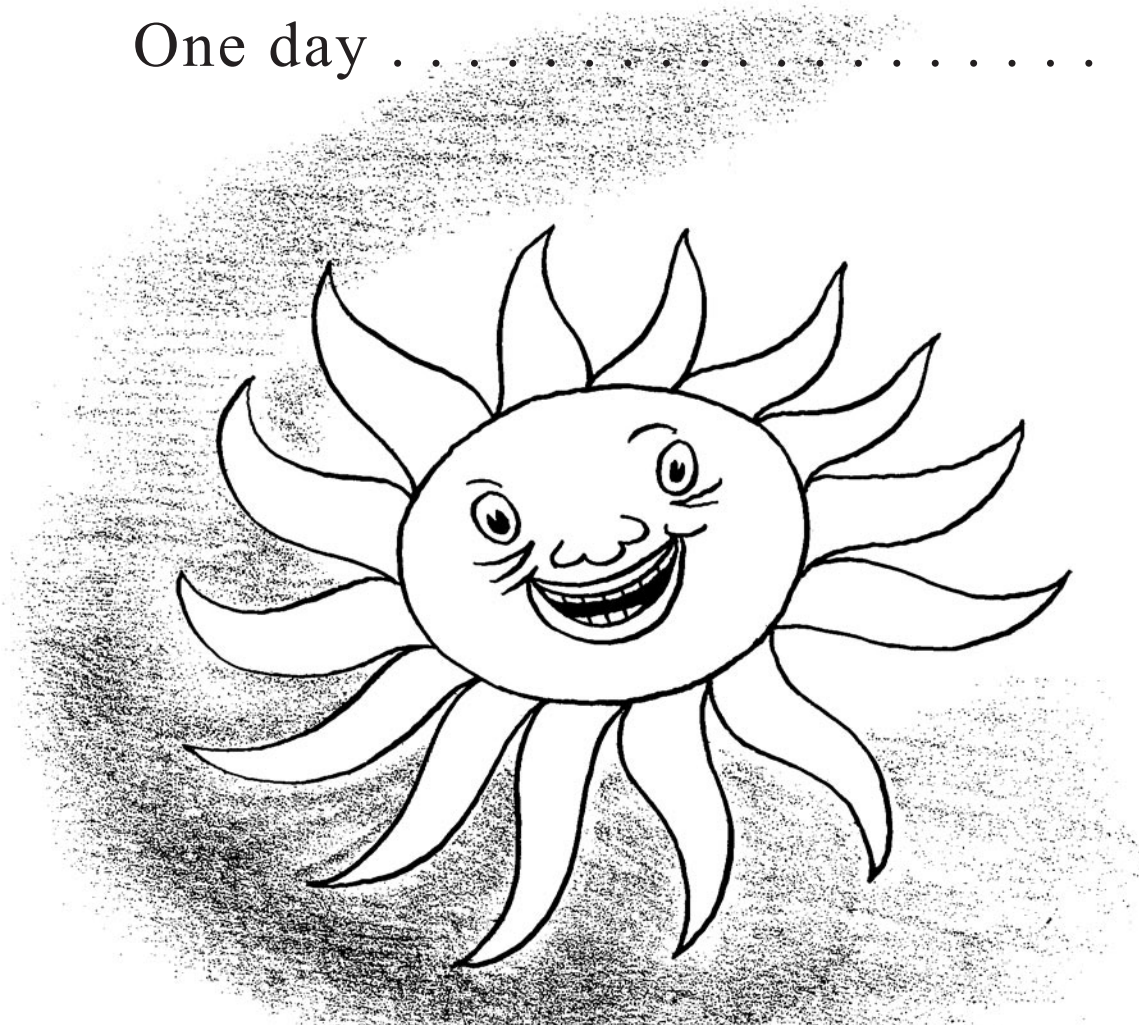
Once upon a time there were three little horses. One was named Whitey because she was white all over.

Now these three little horses were the closest of friends. They grazed together in the lovely, thick grass, and wherever one went, the other two went also.

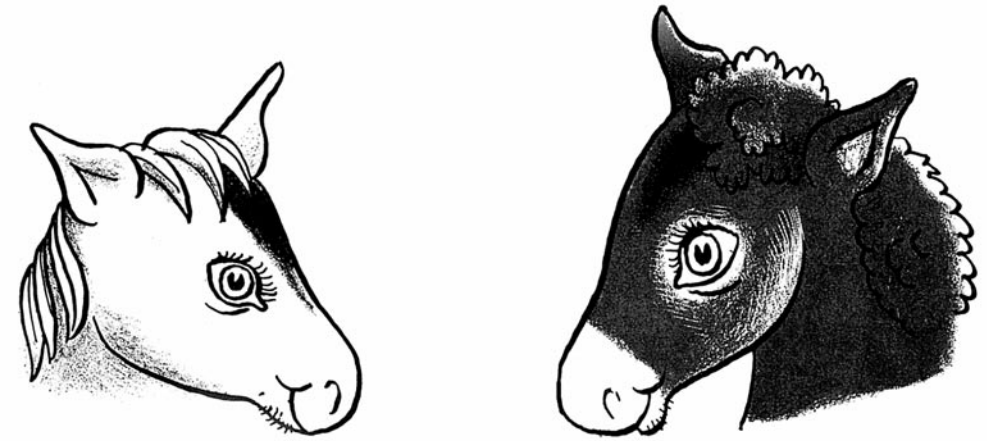

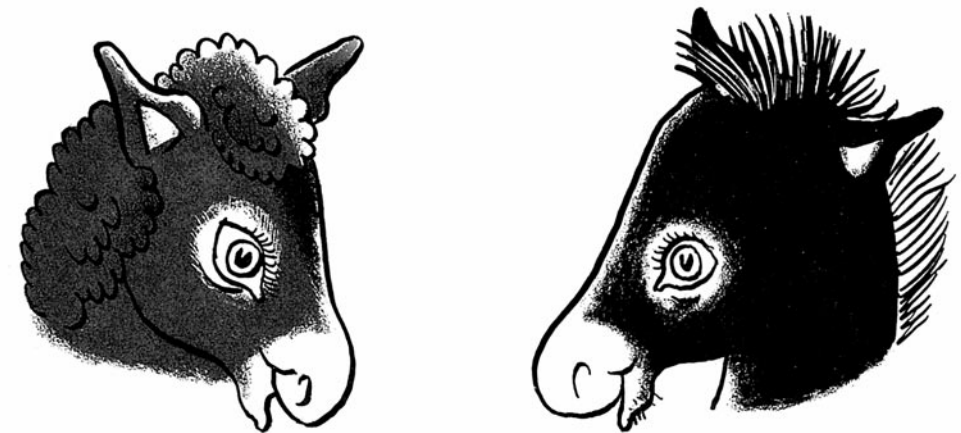
when the sun was shining brightly in the sky, Whitey said to her friends, “Let’s do something really exciting something
