



With Fish & Fish, her tableware collection for Serax, the Italian designer Paola Navone draws admiring glances at once. Fish & Fish was inspired by the tastes and colours of her many travels and is based on the products made during the Great Depression in the 1930s.

Accessible, solid and meticulously studied, this service collection will find its way to all possible tables. The plates, jars and bottles are made of pressed glass and available in Jadeite (green), Milk Glass (white) and Depression Glass (transparent). The service bears the Italian designer's distinctive hallmarks: original, unique and colourful. The Vaiselle Fish & Fish exhibition continues to run up to 5 February at the Concept Store Merci in Paris. Eye-stoppers

include Paola Navone's service for Serax and the launch of a book by Daniel Rozensroch and Cathie Fidler entitled Hareng [Herring]. The exhibition is already one of the highlights of the Paris Design Week.

In addition to the service, the eye-catcher on every table this spring, the Italian designer has brought out a collection of seats and side tables. Fine lines in lacquered white metal define the different objects. The playful lines transform every room, terrace or garden into a space to enjoy. Complete relaxation is guaranteed in the lounge chair where you can stretch leisurely and enjoy the first sunrays of the spring. The lounge chair is available as a single or double seat. The side tables are available in five different sizes.
