Container Grown Trees Planting Instructions

- 1. Dig hole twice as wide but only as deep as the root ball.
- 2. Amend heavy clay soils with bark or compost at a rate of 1 part amendment to two parts soil.
- 3. Ensure bottom of hole is level and firm.
- 4. Gently remove tree from container by bumping down on rim of container with the palm of your hand.
- 5. Carefully back fill sole in hole.
- 6. Build 4 5 inch soil ridge around the hole.
- 7. Check moisture level of soil daily by digging down 2-3 inches to see if soil is damp. If dry, water thoroughly.
- 8. Apply 3 inches of bark mulch to reduce weed growth and retain moisture.
- 9. Stake tree using 1 stake per caliper inch of tree. (Example: 3 inch tree requires three stakes minimum.) Remove stakes after 1 full growth season.
- 10. Fertilize in early spring and late summer. Follow recommendations on fertilizer label.
