Cassia: Cassia corymbosa

Bright yellow flowers summer to fall. Average 7 to 8 feet tall.

Duranta: Duranta repens

Showy, dark blue cluster of flowers all summer, forming golden colored fruit, hence the name of Golden Dew Drops. Upright arching growth habit averaging 6' in the fall. Attracts butterflies. Purple and white blooms on 'Sweet Memories' cultivar.

American Beautyberry: Callicarpa Americana

Outstanding fall berry color on this native shrub. Rosy-purple berries, sun or partial shade. 4' tall.

Yellow Bells Esperanza: Tecoma stans

Large cluster of yellow flowers from early summer into fall. Fast growing shrub averaging 6' to 8'. Deciduous. Drought tolerant when established. Sun.

Retama, Jerusalem Thorn: Parkinsonia aculeata

Spring and summer flowering tree with beautiful, fragrant yellow blooms. Averages 20' tall. Deciduous. Full sun and drought tolerant. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.

Chaste Tree: Vitex agnus-castus

Drought tolerant, sun loving small multi-trunk shrub or tree up to 18' tall. White, pink, or purple blooming varieties that bloom all summer into fall.

Zebra Grass, Miscanthus zebrina

Excellent tall ornamental grass. Green and white variegation. Beautiful linear feature near a water feature or in a rock garden. Versatile and tolerant of drought and poor drainage. Inflorescences excellent for floral design.
