Quick Guide: Veno-Scorp X73 Gaming Headset - PC

1. Connect to PC:

- Use the provided USB cable to connect the Base Station to your PC.

2. Charge Headset:

- Place the headset on the Base Station; a flashing red light indicates proper placement and charging. The blinking light stops once the device is fully charged.

3. Download and Install Driver:

- Visit www.veno-scorp.co.uk/pages/x73-gaming-headset-driver to download the driver.
- Unzip the folder using any file extraction software, such as **Winrar**, and run Setup.exe, following on-screen instructions.

4. Configure Audio Settings:

- Once installed, select X73 as your microphone and audio device in your PC settings.

5. Mute/Unmute Microphone:

- The microphone is initially set to "mute" by default.
- To unmute, press the mute button on the headset. The active status is indicated by the blue light on the microphone.

1. Connect to PlayStation:

- Use the USB cable to connect the Base Station to your PlayStation.

2. Charge Headset:

- Place the headset on the Base Station; a flashing red light indicates proper placement and charging. The blinking light stops once the device is fully charged.

3. Configure Audio Settings:

- On your PlayStation, go to Speaker Settings.
- Select X73 as both your audio output and microphone.

4. Mute/Unmute Microphone:

- The microphone is initially set to "mute" by default.
- To unmute, press the mute button on the headset. The active status is indicated by the blue light on the microphone.

Docking Mode:

- 1. Connect the Base Station to the Nintendo Switch using the USB cable.
- 2. Place the headset on the Base Station; a flashing red light indicates proper placement and The blinking light stops once the device is fully charged.
- 3. Your audio/mic functionality should operate automatically; however, if not, navigate to the Nintendo Switch speaker settings and choose X73 for both audio output and microphone.
- 4. The microphone is initially set to "mute" by default. To unmute the microphone, press the mute button on the headset.

Handheld Mode:

1. Simply connect the X73 headset to the Nintendo Switch using the AUX cable.

Quick Guide: Veno-Scorp X73 Gaming Headset -Xbox

1. Connect to Xbox:

- Connect the Base Station to your Xbox using the USB cable and optical cable, Switch the audio source to optical by adjusting the switch located on the rear of the base station. The optical cable is not provided with the headset.

2. Charge Headset:

- Place the headset on the Base Station; a flashing red light indicates proper placement and charging. The blinking light stops once the device is fully charged.

3. Configure Audio Settings:

- Go to Xbox audio settings, selecting X73 for audio output.

Voice Chat: Please be aware that voice chat is not supported via our headset for Xbox.

Using AUX Cable:

1. For mobiles with an AUX port, connect the X73 headset using the provided AUX cable.

Using Type C (with Adapter):

- 1. Purchase an Aux to Type C adapter if your mobile device has a Type C port.
- 2. Connect the X73 headset to your mobile using the AUX cable and the Type C adapter.
