



Name: Princess Margaret

Occupation: Princess

Connection to Douglas McIntyre:

You encountered him at upper-class soirées here in London.

Secrets: You have been having an affair with the caviar tycoon, Turner Anguille.

Why you're at the party: You fear McIntyre found out about the affair and it's in his book.

Relationships: Turner Anguille is your secret lover. Poppy Anguille you view as competition. You're friendly with everyone else.

Before the party: You attended a charity croquet match. You left early because you were losing, and your chauffeur drove you straight to the hotel.

Gameplay

1. The players are given their character booklets at the start of the party, which include bios and objectives/tasks for each round, and the host starts the game.
2. The host will read aloud their speech.
3. All the guests then have about 30 minutes to chat, referring to their Round 1 objectives.
4. This repeats for two more rounds throughout the evening.
5. The game ends with the host's closing speech.
6. Players then decide on the suspects and vote.
7. The killer reveals themself!

Rules

- Only read your character objectives at the start of each round!
- The murderer is the only person who is allowed to lie (besides the host). Everyone else may change the subject, bluster, storm off, etc. but must always tell the truth when pressed. You cannot ask other players directly if they're the murderer, though!
- Stay in character! It's okay to laugh but try always to return to your character.
- Engage with everyone—your goal is to figure out who the murderer is, and the best way to do that is by speaking with as many people as you can to find out what they know!

Round 1

- You're meant to be avoiding one another in public, but you can't help yourself—you're curious about Turner's wife. Go introduce yourself to Poppy and ask after her husband.

Round 2

- With McIntyre dead, does that mean his book will no longer be published? Is your secret safe? You noticed Percy Hoskins, a journalist, is here. Ask him if he knows whether the book will still be published with McIntyre gone.

Round 3

- The stress of the evening is almost too much for you—you simply can't be connected to another scandal. Ask Noël if he knows what will be in McIntyre's book—you want to find out if he knew about your affair, and Noël was a work colleague of his.
