Connection to Douglas McIntyre:

Your husband is in business with McIntyre.

Secrets: You suspect your husband is having an affair, though you're uncertain who with. You also know that Turner owes McIntyre money after a series of investments gone wrong.

Why you're at the party: You suspect your husband's mistress may be at this party.

Relationships: You distrust Turner as you suspect an affair. You have a crush on Percy Hoskins, as he has lent a sympathetic ear to your worries on numerous occasions. You're friends with Noël, a fellow theater-lover.

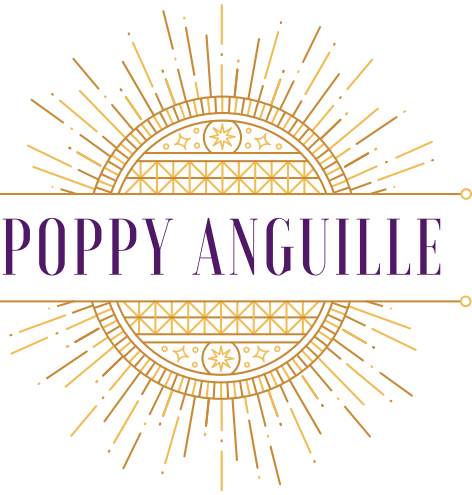
Before the party: You ate dinner with your husband at your estate. Turner left early because he felt unwell and went for a walk to calm his stomach. He met you at the hotel.

Gameplay

1. The players are given their character booklets at the start of the party, which include bios and objectives/tasks for each round, and the host starts the game.
2. The host will read aloud their speech.
3. All the guests then have about 30 minutes to chat, referring to their Round 1 objectives.
4. This repeats for two more rounds throughout the evening.
5. The game ends with the host's closing speech.
6. Players then decide on the suspects and vote.
7. The killer reveals themself!

Rules

- Only read your character objectives at the start of each round!
- The murderer is the only person who is allowed to lie (besides the host). Everyone else may change the subject, bluster, storm off, etc. but must always tell the truth when pressed. You cannot ask other players directly if they're the murderer, though!
- Stay in character! It's okay to laugh but try always to return to your character.
- Engage with everyone—your goal is to figure out who the murderer is, and the best way to do that is by speaking with as many people as you can to find out what they know!



POPPY ANGUILE

A well-to-do gentlewoman, you adore the theatre and the arts, and fancy yourself something of an amateur theater critic. Raised in high society, you can hobnob with the best of them.

Round 1

- Say hello to Percy and confide in him your concerns about the affair, letting slip that you are thinking about a divorce. Perhaps there's a future with him instead.

Round 2

- A murder! How gruesome. It really makes you think. Go to Noël seeking comfort—and confide in him your troubles with Turner and your feelings for Percy. What should you do?

Round 3

- You're sick of all these secrets and lies. You don't care who knows what anymore. Confront Turner about the affair. Tell him you want a divorce.
