



Name: Turner Anguille

Occupation: Caviar tycoon

Connection to Douglas McIntyre:

McIntyre is invested in your business

Secrets: You have been having an affair with Margaret. You also owe McIntyre after he gave you a loan for your (secretly) failing caviar business.

Why you're at the party: You do business with McIntyre.

Relationships: Poppy Anguille is your wife. HRH Princess Margaret is your secret lover.

Before the party: You ate dinner with your wife at your estate. You left early because you felt unwell and went for a walk to calm your stomach. You met your wife at the hotel.

Shh! You are the murderer! Don't tell anyone. When you left dinner early, you went to the hotel to kill McIntyre. You couldn't pay him back and feared your secret getting out.

Gameplay

1. The players are given their character booklets at the start of the party, which include bios and objectives/tasks for each round, and the host starts the game.
2. The host will read aloud their speech.
3. All the guests then have about 30 minutes to chat, referring to their Round 1 objectives.
4. This repeats for two more rounds throughout the evening.
5. The game ends with the host's closing speech.
6. Players then decide on the suspects and vote.
7. The killer reveals themself!

Rules

- Only read your character objectives at the start of each round!
- The murderer is the only person who is allowed to lie (besides the host). Everyone else may change the subject, bluster, storm off, etc. but must always tell the truth when pressed. You cannot ask other players directly if they're the murderer, though!
- Stay in character! It's okay to laugh but try always to return to your character.
- Engage with everyone—your goal is to figure out who the murderer is, and the best way to do that is by speaking with as many people as you can to find out what they know!



TURNER ANGUILE

A well-to-do gentleman with an inherited caviar business, you are accustomed to the finer things in life. You imagine yourself something of an accomplished businessman and tend to view yourself above others.

Round 1

- Ask at least one person when they think McIntyre is going to arrive, as you have an important business matter to discuss with him. If anyone asks what, tell them it's confidential. You want to make it seem like you're expecting McIntyre to show up.
- Discreetly pull aside HRH Margaret and break off the affair--the last thing you need right now is a royal scandal. Tell her you must avoid one another from now on.

Round 2

- Act distraught that McIntyre is dead—you need to appear shocked. Go comfort Poppy.

Round 3

- Attempt to shift suspicion onto anyone but yourself (questioning others' motives and whereabouts, spilling secrets, etc.)
