



Mug Rug

Such a fun project! Make a mug rug for the perfect hostess gift or sell them at your local holiday market. There are endless creative possibilities of design, color and layout to create the most fun little pad for the mug.

Pattern piece: 8 1/2" x 11" sheet of paper







- 1. Using an 8 1/2" x 11" sheet of paper, cut out one interfacing and one batting.
- Cut out block from panel. Place block on interfacing straight or angled. On straight version, block will be slightly smaller, this will be covered by binding. Begin stitching strips of coordinating fabrics as shown.
- 3. When top is covered, edgestitch from back side and trim excess strips.
- 4. Place on top of batting and stitch between strips to give a quilted, interesting texture.
- 5. Cut backing 1" larger all around than top and bind from the back, mitering corners.

Backing and Binding

13" x 10 1/2"

Pattern pieces are drawn to scale so you may enlarge them to your desired size!
