

One Strap Mask

This is a great little mask! 11" of 43" wide fabric will make 2 masks.
Cut and stitch in less than 10 minutes!

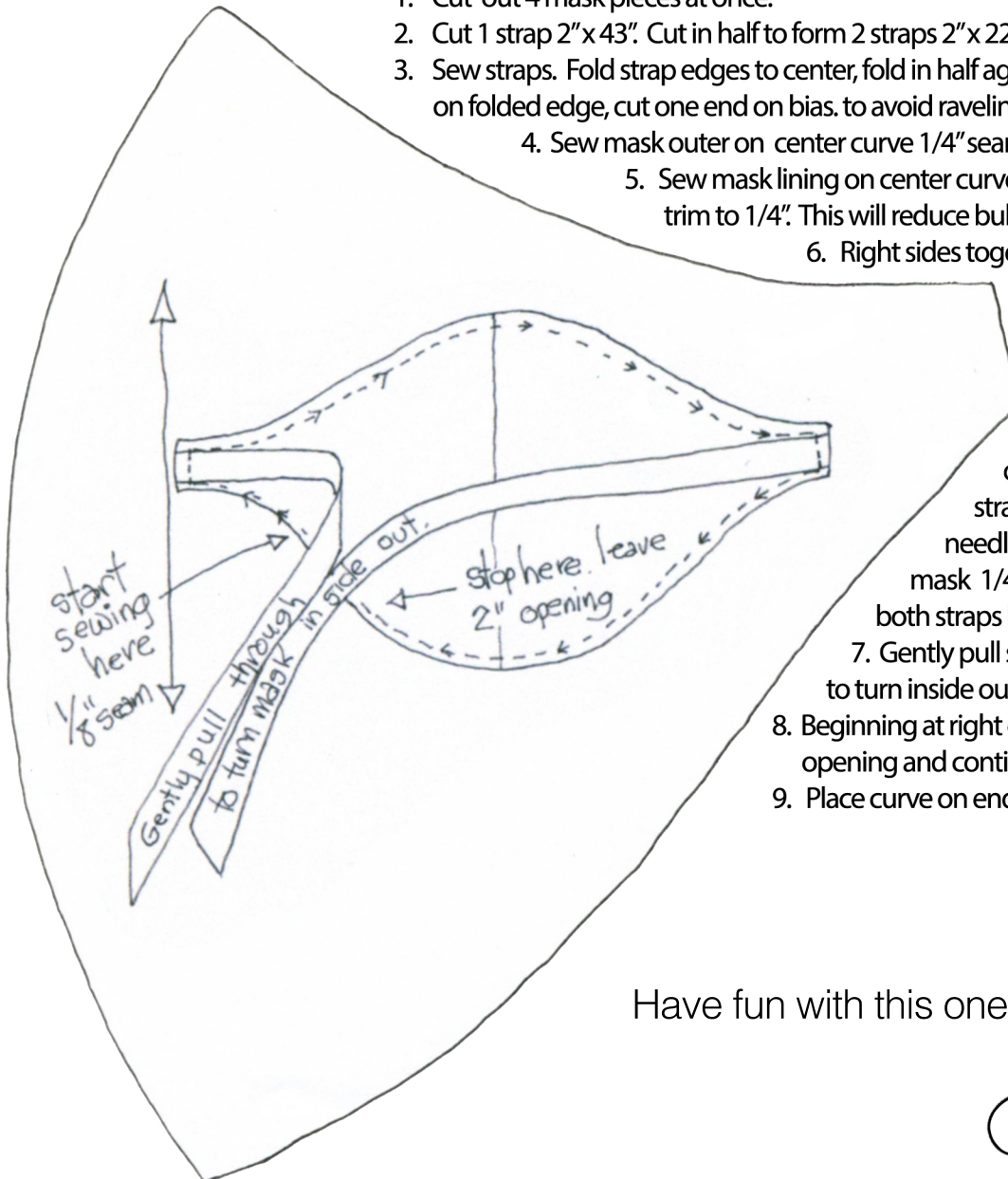
1. Cut out 4 mask pieces at once.
2. Cut 1 strap 2" x 43". Cut in half to form 2 straps 2" x 22"
3. Sew straps. Fold strap edges to center, fold in half again. Edge stitch on folded edge, cut one end on bias. to avoid raveling.
4. Sew mask outer on center curve 1/4" seam.
5. Sew mask lining on center curve 1/2" seam.
trim to 1/4". This will reduce bulk inside mask.

6. Right sides together, begin sewing

1 1/2" from corner 1/4" seam
Place straight end of strap at edge
stitch across end. Needle down,
turn and stitch across upper
edge of mask 1/4" seam to
other side. Place second
strap on side edge, sew across end,
needle down, stitch lower edge of
mask 1/4". Leave 2" opening with
both straps hanging out.

7. Gently pull straps through opening
to turn inside out.

8. Beginning at right corner, edge stitch to close opening and continue all around mask
9. Place curve on end of ironing board to press.
