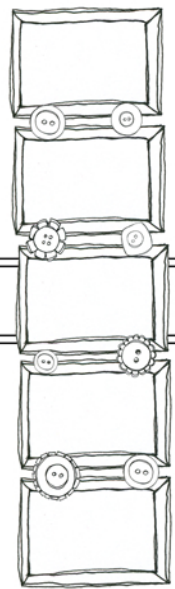

Wee Wall Hanging

Made with "shortie blocks" (5" x 4") this mini wall hanging with fit in the smallest spot to send out it's comfort rays! Make it as long or short as you like, mix with 5" x 5" blocks to create your desired affect and message, embellish with sweet colorful buttons to match it's sweet message!



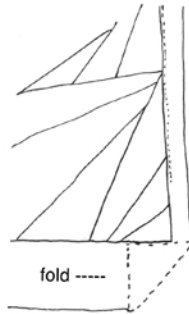
Instruction

Materials

Tip

1. Cut out "shortie" blocks as desired
2. Cut out interfacing and batting to match.
3. Cut out backing 7" x 6"
4. Sandwich batting between block and interfacing. Pin "shortie" block, batting and interfacing together. Edge stitch on back on interfacing all around.
5. Center "shortie" on backing wrong sides together, pin
6. Bind from back, mitering corners. Fold excess backing in half to edge of block to form binding. Edgestitch using preferred stitch style. At corners, fold binding on bias to edge, fold to edge again to form miter.
7. Press gently from back side.
8. Tack together 1" from outside edge
9. Embellish with fun buttons!

Heavyweight tear away interfacing
Your favorite batting, scraps?

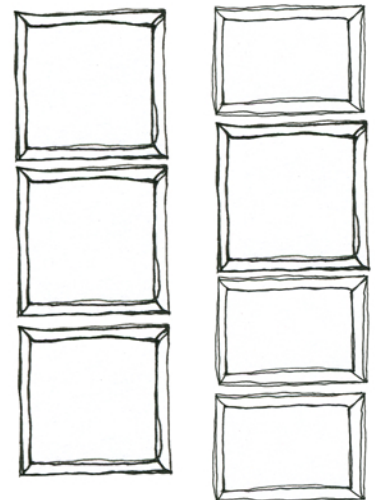


Stop stitching about 3" before edge of block, needle down, to work on your miter.

Assort them, pile them up, have fun!

I like to spray starch blocks and backing for more stability in the process.

It is helpful to use a large pin to coax the corner folds into a perfect miter. Takes a little practice.



Compose your message by your block arrangement!
