


## 1. POCKET PANEL

You will need:

- a. cut 2-2 block pockets
- b. cut 2 coordinate side panels 5" wide x height of pockets
- c. stitch pocket panel sections together 1/2"



- f. cut out pocket panel lining to match pocket panel
- g. RST sew top of pocket panel together 1/2" seam open seam, understitch lining & seam allowance.
- h. sew side seam closed to form circle 1//2", press open
- i. fold over at top, press top edge, staystitch bottom edge

## 2. TOTE BODY

- a. Cut tote body 40" x 18" (if using pet screen, piece together to achieve 40", grainline up & down only)
- b. cut binding 2"x 42" (bias or straight of grain)
- c. apply binding to top edge
- d. sew pocket panel to tote body at bottom
- e. sew pocket panel to tote body between blocks to create separate pockets

## 3. TOTE BOTTOM

- a. cut double layer of fabric and stiffener of choice 16" x 5"
- b. RST sew pocket panel to edge of bottom matching seams at corners, 1/4" turn inside out

## 4. GROMMETS & STRAP

- a. paper bag fold top edge of tote at sides approx 2 1/2". Center grommets in fold 2 1/2" down from top edge, attach
- b. cut strap 2 strips of coordinate fabric 5" wide by 45", seam together, RST edgestitch strap closed angle ends. Turn inside out, press. Lace through grommets and tie bow.
