# Materials:

Doggie Dear Embroidery

1/4 yd dupioni silk or Kona Cotton

1/2 yd quilted pocket panel lining

4 fat qtrs coordinates

1/4 yd binding fabric

1/2 yd strap fabric


1 yd pet screen or other basic fabric



# INSTRUCTIONS


# 1. POCKET PANEL

- A. stitch out 4 doggies
- B. trim to 6 1/4" x 8 1/4"
- c. cut 4 coordinate sashings 2" x 45", border each stitch out, 1/4" seam
- d. sew blocks together front and back sections, 1/4"





- e. cut 2 end panels, coordinates 5" x 9"
- f. sew pocket panel sections together 1/4" press seams open



- g. cut lining to match pocket panel
- h. sew lining and pocket panel sideseams to form closed circle, press seams open
- i. WST, edge stitch lining to panel top and bottom
- j. cut binding 48" x 3", apply to top edge of pocket panel

#### 2. TOTE BODY


- a. cut tote body (pet screen will need to be pieced to maintain grainline orientation) 46" x 16"
- b. sew sideseam in tote body
- c. cut binding 48" x 3", apply to top of tote body edgestitch bottom of pocket panel to tote body bottom, sew between blocks to form separate pockets.

### 3. TOTE BOTTOM

- a. cut double layer of fabric and stiffener of choice 20" x5"
- b. edgestitch tote bottom sandwich all around
- c. RST sew pocket panel to edge of tote bottom matching seams at corners, 1/4", turn inside out

# 4. GROMMETS & STRAPS

a. paper bag fold top edge of tote at sides approx 2 1/2". Center grommets in fold 2" down from top edge, attach.



b. cut strap 2 strips of coordinate fabric 5" x 45", seam together, RST edgestitch strap closed, angle ends. Turn inside out, press. Lace through grommets and tie bow.
