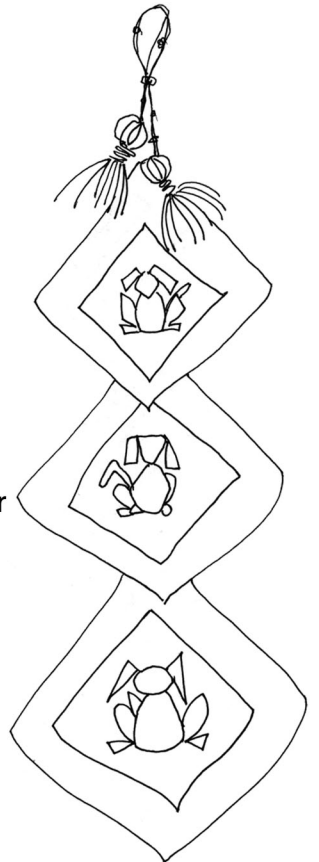




# Doggie Holiday

## Doggie Holiday Diamond Wall Hanging (or table runner)



Such a fun, flexible, forgiving project! The Doggie Holiday Diamond Wall hanging can be configured using 3 separate crazy quilted finished blocks as sampled or more blocks can be added to showcase the many cute designs in this 4x4" embroidery collection. A design from one of the blocks from the Doggie Holiday panel fabric could also be used. Any number of fun blocks can be created and arranged to fit any desired space and use. Looks really cute on the back of a door, designs can be turned sideways and used as a table runner. Simple to make and finish off with a perky yarn tassel hanger. The perfect holiday project!

### Materials needed:

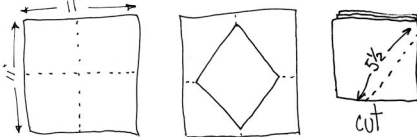
As many fun fat quarters as you like. I used about 15 different patterns.

1/2 yard backing fabric, or 3 different prints, 17" square

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### 1. Make diamond template.

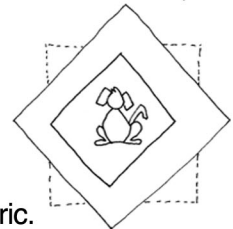
- a. Fold 11" square of paper into fourths, cut corner off 5 1/2" across



- b. Use template window to place embroidery on your stitch out and back fabric.

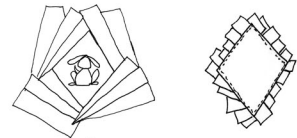
Mark diamond with heat release pen.

- c. Trim excess from stitch out



#### 2. Crazy Quilt

- a. Random crazy quilt using 2" strips, beginning with window.  
b. Stitch down and press back until entire surface is covered.  
c. Flip over and edge stitch outside edge of diamond, trim off excess using rotary cutter and ruler.

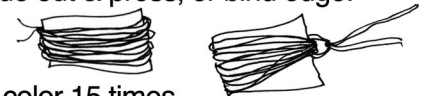


#### 3. Stitch to thin batting

4. Line with backing fabric, right sides together, leave opening, turn inside out & press, or bind edge.

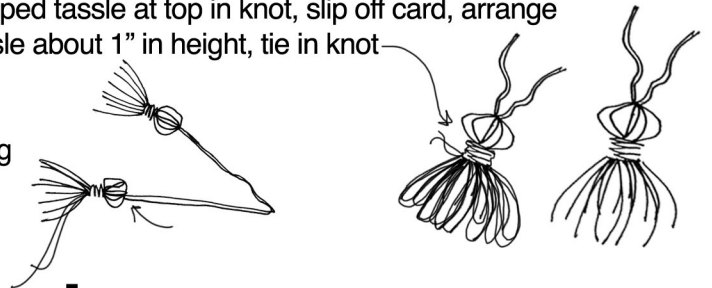
#### 5. Tassel Hanger

- a. Using a flexible (cardboard or plastic) rectangle about 5" x 3" wrap first color 20 times, wrap second color 15 times, wrap third color 15 times  
b. Using 2 yards of 2 colors of yarn, tie wrapped tassel at top in knot, slip off card, arrange  
c. Using 1 yard of 2 colors wrap neck of tassel about 1" in height, tie in knot  
d. Cut yarn loops and trim



#### 6. Tassel #2

- a. Repeat process for tassel #1 incorporating end of 2 yard pcs in second tassel.



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
