
# Flower Fun with




This project is a free-standing net flower 6" in diameter with three-dimensional petals and center with tendrils. The flower is a prototype illustrating the technique for creating the flower which can be made in any type of fabric, color, size, etc. The possibilities are unlimited. The flower is perfect as an embellishment for a bag, hair ornament, pillow, corsage, etc.

- 1. Base flower design stitch-out from "Frilly Flowers" I
- 2. Petals stitch-out from "Frilly Flowers" I & II
- 3. 3" yo yo pattern and corsage pin
- 4. yo-yo flower center fabric and stuffing
- 5. button (optional alternative flower center)
- 6. pipe cleaner
- 7. yarn

# INSTRUCTIONS



1. Using 3" circle pattern, cut out yo yo



# **Base Flower**

- 3. Trim jump stitches from stitch-outs
- 4. Cut out base flower design

### **Petals**

5. Cut out petals

6. Gather petals with ruffler or string together by hand


# **Arrange & Assemble**

- 7. Arrange petals and tack to secure in place. Pin to center of base flower design from the back side
- 8. Pin stuffed yo yo to center of petals from the back side
- 9. Tack from back side to secure.

### Curlie tendril

10. Wrap pipe cleaner with yarn, stitch to back between base flower and petals.

TIP

The tiny pleats made by the ruffler will be easier to arrange later

Use corsage pin

Wrap from center of pipe cleaner to each end, tie off in center. Curl with finger or pencil.
