

- 1. Use 2 fabric panels (not cut apart) to create lap quilt top approx 42" x 48".
- 2. Cut batting to match quilt top.
- 3. Cut quilt backing 2" larger that quilt top. Example: quilt top 42"x 48" quilt back 44" x 50".
- 4. Lay backing down flat, right side down. Center batting and quilt top (right side up) on backing with 1" of backing showing on all sides. Pin.
- 5. Quilt as desired. Allover free-motion, around blocks etc.

6. Binding: Fold excess backing in half to edge of quilt top, fold over edge of quilt top to form binding. Edge stitch using preferred stitch style. At corners, fold binding on bias to edge, fold to edge again to form miter.



Stop stitching about 3" before corner, needle down, to work on your miter.
