

Vintage Bib Apron

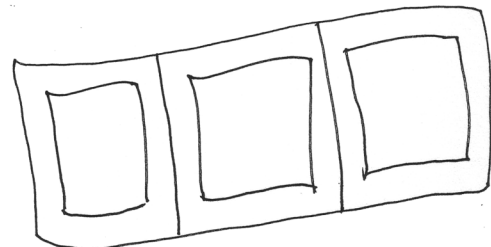

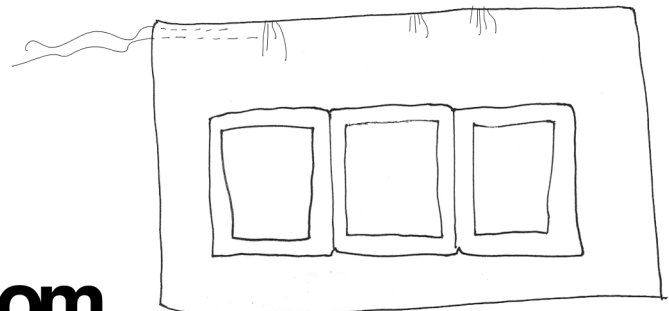
This classic, feminine vintage apron is the perfect display space for your favorite embroidery designs. Use a fun combination of fabrics color coordinated with your special embroideries and you will have the perfect, unique apron for your own use, a fun gift or just a charming kitchen decoration!

You will need about 1 yd of 45" fabric.

1. Stitch out design on bib section
Trim to 8" x 10"
2. Bind across top and sides to form neck strap. Cut binding 3" wide by about 45" long
3. Stitch out 3 pocket designs, trim to 5" x 5"
Border with 2" strips, 1/4" seams
Sew together to form pocket panel, face, press



4. Cut apron skirt 18" x 34", hem. Sew pocket panel to center
5. Gather skirt and attach to center of waistband
Cut waistband 5" x 72". Sew bib to center of waistband



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
