COLLECTION OF INFORMATION

We collect personal information that you provide us when you open an account or place an order. You may provide us with your name, postal and billing addresses, phone numbers, email addresses and date of birth. When you buy something on our website, we collect information about your order such as items purchased, when and where you bought it and what type of payment you used. We will keep your data for as long as lawfully required for the purposes for which it was collected.

We may also collect your IP address.

If you do provide sensitive information, by providing that information you explicitly consent to us using it for the purposes for which it has been provided.

When you submit your personal information you are asked to consent to us using your information for the purposes set forth in this privacy policy and our terms & conditions. We only collect information that you provide to us: if you would prefer us not to collect any personal information from you, please do not provide us with any such information. The information we request from you for the purposes of processing an order is required for this purpose: if you fail to provide this information we reserve the right not to accept your order.

WHAT YOUR INFORMATION IS USED FOR

We use the personal information we collect to process your transactions and administer and operate your account, in order to supply you with the goods and services you buy or wish to buy, help you with placing orders, or communicate with you while your order is in process or production.
