This work was created on Boon Wurrung country at Crib Point in Westernport Bay where the proposed 17 story floating AGL gas storage facility. If it goes ahead it will destroy the delicate seagrass ecosystem that supports the health of Westernport Bay, including the most southerly mangrove system in the world. The area is a designated Ramsar site in which Australia signed the convention to conserve the ecological, botanical, zoological, limnological and hydrological areas for migratory bird health.

My daughter holds up her hand painted placard and continues the tradition of 4 generations of environmental protective action in my family in the Westernport Bay area. She is also part of the new generation of children that has seen millions of school age children around the world demand climate action for a healthier planet. This movement has given her hope. It has inspired me to take more positive action for ecological preservation.
