! Before you start applying your Decowall Self Stick Wallpaper, please read these notes and instructions:

- Take time and work slowly to avoid any mistakes.
- Prepare a large work area and don't crowd yourself.
- Gently smooth out the paper surface without putting too much pressure on the face of the wallpaper.
- Once removed, the wallpaper cannot be reused. Whilst adhesiveness may still remain, the shape and design will not.
- Self Stick Wallpaper can be applied onto any types of walls and any furniture such as old wardrobes, cupboards, shelves and tables.

You will need...



Dry cloth



Plastic card or Squeegee



Craft cutter



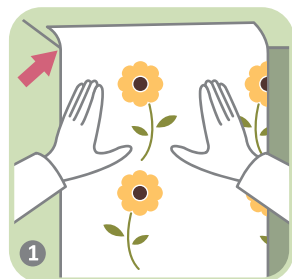
Scissors

How to apply Self Stick Wallpaper



1. Prepare the walls.

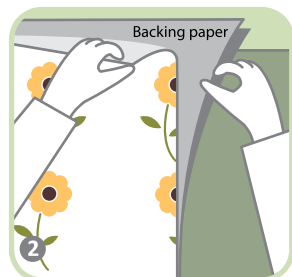
Wash any dirt or dust from the walls and sand smooth any chipped paint. Remove the old wallpaper using a wallpaper remover. Cracks and irregularities should be filled with a suitable filler.



2. Hang the wallpaper.

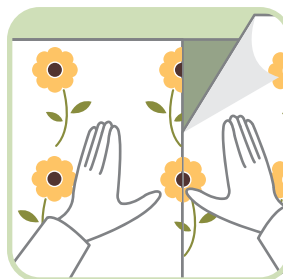
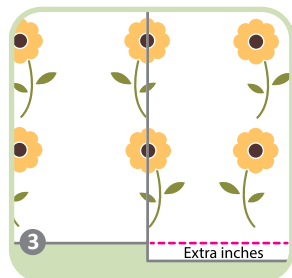
Start from the top left corner of the wall (image1).

When the strip is in the correct position, peel the backing paper (image2) and gently smooth down the middle of the wallpaper with a squeegee or dry cloth, ensuring a good butt joint and pattern match, then work outwards towards the edges, removing any air bubbles.



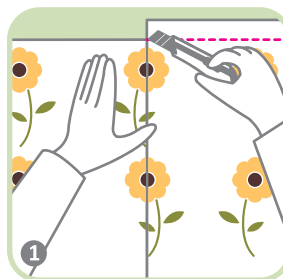
If you need, to leave a few extra inches of paper at the top and bottom for trimming later (image3).

*** Considering the properties of PVC, please remove the wallpaper slowly from its backing paper as pulling it straight out may damage the product. The product may also become slightly stretched when applying due to the surrounding temperature and**



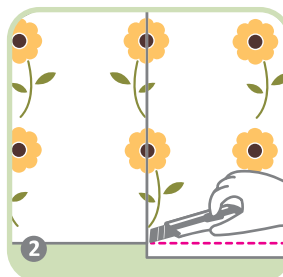
3. Hang the Remaining Pieces.

Hang the second piece, starting at the top. Line up the seams as closely as possible, and try to match the patterns exactly. Smooth out the second piece as in the previous step. Continue with each piece in the same manner.



4. Trim the Edges.

Trim away any excess wallpaper using a utility knife or putty knife (Image 1) (Image 2).
