Submission Directions and Cover Sheet. Please read carefully.

Please include one submission sheet per entry. Your submission verifies that your work meets the requirements for originality and you grant Renaissance Institute permission to publish your work.

Artwork Requirements

- Any 2-or 3-dimensional work of art in any medium can be submitted (drawings, paintings, collage, graphic design, ceramics, woodworking, knitting and sewing, etc.)
- Artwork copied from copyrighted sources can NOT be published, while open source/public domain/Creative Commons copies CAN be published. Indicate the source of what you are copying/reproducing.
- Two-dimensional pieces may be submitted in frames, but not under glass. (Glass interferes with the quality of the photography of your piece).

Photography Requirements:

- All photography must be submitted digitally. Only JPEG, PSD or TIFF files can be used. Proper image resolution is 300 DPI with an image size of 5x7" minimum. (Smaller file sizes are not suitable for professional printing.)
- If working with a phone camera, send the largest file size you can. We will inform you if it is not large enough to use in *Reflections*.

The Submission Process:

- Each entry will be juried by a committee of Renaissance members.
- All photography should be submitted to the2suttons@gmail.com. You will be informed upon receipt.
- We will ensure that your work will be properly secured while in RI custody. Art work will be available for pickup at the Renaissance office after February 7. (Tuesday-Thursday 9 AM-3 PM)
- THERE IS A LIMIT OF THREE (3) SUBMISSIONS IN EACH OF THE TWO CATEGORIES, ART AND PHOTOGRAPHY.
