

Off-Licence

Sections 17, 18 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **The Landing Wines Company** is authorized to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **623 Rangihoua Road, Kerikeri 0294**, Far North District and known as "**The Landing Wines**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

*Endorsement – Section 40 off-licenses for remote sellers of alcohol

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold, supplied, or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 9.00 am to 6.00 pm.
Anytime of any day for remote sales
- (c) The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- (d) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (e) **The entire premises is undesignated.**
- (f) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises and signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.
- (g) Alcohol sold by remote sale is not delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11.00pm on any day and before 6.00am on the next day.
- (h) The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that the holder sells by remote sale is not under the purchase age.
- (i) Remote sale via the Internet must comply with any regulations made under this Act requiring information to be visible on the holder's Website, when people browse, enter or otherwise access it.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorized in or from the premises generally. The premises, situated at **623 Rangihoua Road, Kerikeri 0294**, Far North District, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Far North District Licensing Committee on **16th November 2020**.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance through an automatic glass door is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force –

- (a) either –
 - I. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - II. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either-
 - I. Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - II. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
