



British Para Table Tennis Ranking System

For a player with an international ranking, the individual would keep the order as per international class ranking list.

Everyone to start from 0 in the first national tournament of the year. i.e. April 2024.

The workings of the revised points system are as follows in a class event at a Grand Prix:

- 20 points for a win against an international player
- 15 points for a win against a higher ranked player
- 10 points for a win against a similar standard player
- 5 points for a win against a lower ranked player

In an open event at a Grand Prix:

- 10 points for a win against an international player
- 8 points for a win against a higher ranked player
- 5 points for a win against a similar ranked player

For doubles and restricted events: only receive match bonuses

Junior and Women only ranking lists work as class system above

Match Bonuses:

- Progression from group stages = +1 point
- Progression from quarter-finals = +2 points
- Progression from semi-finals = +3 points
- Finalists = each receive 4 points

British Para Table Tennis National Championships: Double points apply

- At the start of each season, each player loses 15 points.
- If you fall off the international ranking list but still play, you will be allocated 1,000 points.
- Non-competing at an event for 1 year removes you from the ranking list.
- This system can be applied as scoresheets are returned.
- In doubles events, the two ranking points of the players are added together by the referee to enable the draw to take place.
