

CHAIN & CUFF BRACELET SIZE GUIDE

Before using the ruler to find your fit, make sure this guide is printed on US Letter size paper (8.5" x 11") and scaled to 100%. To check the accuracy of your printout, position a credit card under the line below. The scale is correct if the credit card and line length match.



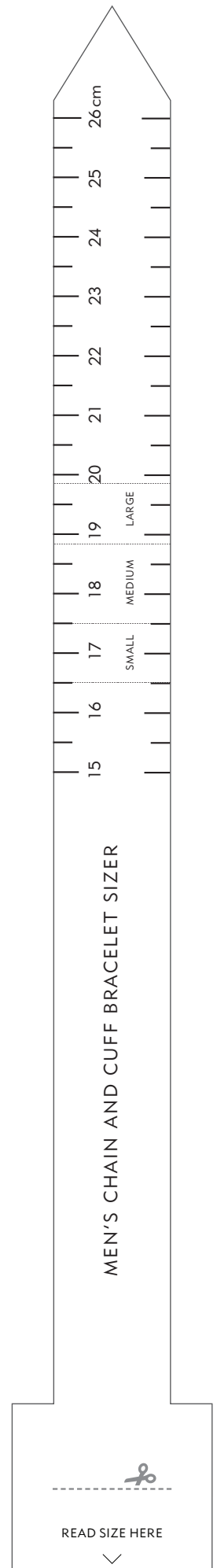
MEASURE YOUR WRIST WITH THE SIZER

- Carefully cut along the outline of the printable bracelet sizer. Make a small slit on the dotted line on the left end of the sizer.
- Wrap the sizer around your wrist just below your wrist bone with the numbers facing out.
- Pull the pointed end of the sizer through the slit. Tighten it to a comfortable fit around your wrist, as tight or loose as you like.
- Find your measurement on the sizer. Compare this measurement to the chart below to find your bracelet size. If you are between sizes, we suggest you opt for the larger size.

WRIST MEASUREMENTS		BRACELET SIZE
6.5" – 6.9"	16.5 – 17.5 cm	Small
6.9" – 7.4"	17.5 – 18.8 cm	Medium
7.4" – 7.8"	18.8 – 19.8 cm	Large

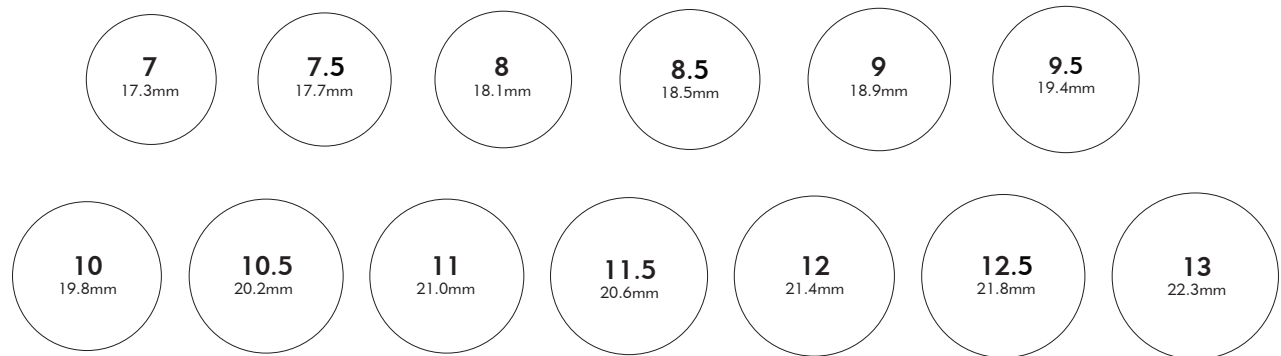
MEN'S RING SIZE GUIDE

Please scale this PDF to 100% and print on US letter-size paper (8.5 x 11").
If a credit card is the same length as the line below, your guide is printed to the correct scale.



OPTION 1: MEASURE BY MATCHING YOUR CURRENT RING

1. Select a ring you already own that perfectly fits the finger on which you will wear your LOUPN ring.
2. Align your ring with the circle below that mostly closely matches in size. The inner edge of your ring should align with the outer edge of the circle. The larger number inside the circle is your ring size.
3. If your ring appears to be between two sizes, we suggest you choose the larger size.



OPTION 2: MEASURE YOUR FINGER WITH PAPER SIZER



Cut along the outline of the sizer. Make a small slit on the line on the left end of the sizer.



Wrap the sizer around the largest part of your finger with the numbers facing out.



Pull the pointed end of the sizer through the slit. Make sure it fits snugly for accuracy.



The number that lines up with the slit represents the ring size for that finger.
