ABULITON

Abutilon, also known as Chinese Lanterns due to the shape of their flowers, are attractive shrubs mostly growing to 1 – 2 m tall. Their pendulous, hibiscus like flowers come in lovely shades of white, orange, yellow and pink and variegated varieties with mottled foliage are available.

LUCKY LANTERN ORANGE LUCKY LANTERN RED LUCKY LANTERN YELLOW		'Lucky Lantern' Abutilons have been bred to stay nice and compact and produce masses of flowers through the summer months. Available in a range of colours they are easy to grow and just require a light trim after flowering to encourage new growth. Feed with a general purpose fertilizer in spring.

AZALEA

Glorious orange, yellow and golden toning provide colourful autumn foliage displays and the most magnificent show of brilliant blooms for long periods each spring. They are extremely hardy to cold, but insist on cool, deep well-drained, acid soil conditions. Peat moss used as a soil conditioner and mulch will help to provide suitable growing conditions, and dressings of aluminum sulphate or flowers of sulphur will help achieve desired acidity. Select the coolest location, provide shelter from strong winds, and provide deep watering during dry spells.

BARBECUE		Double salmon-pink flowers with pale pink & cream markings And an orange flare.
CAROLINE DE ROTHSCHILD		Carmine rose flowers in masses of loose trusses totally smother the plant.
COPPER FRILLS		Very large frilled coppery red flowers in a rounded truss. Scented. A good growerHt. 1.5m. (Ilam cultivar)
DELECTISSMA	5THI	Soft pink flushed deep pink. With prominent orange/yellow flare. Very fragrant. Flowers in November.
DOROTHY CORSTON	5THI	Deep orange red flowers on a compact bush in Nov. Ht. 1m.
ESKIMO PIE		Large tight pure white head with a yellow flare. Scented. Grows approx 1.4m.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY			Pretty blush pink blooms highlighted with a large golden flare have the added bonus of a sweet perfume. Simply beautiful in early spring. 1.5m.
HOME BUSH			Vivid purplish red flowers. Semi-double. Flowers in November. Strong grower. A beautiful Knaphill Ghent Azalea. 1x1m.
JAFFA	5TG		The frilly textured blooms are a brilliant tangerine/orange and create a simply stunning display. Approx 1.5m x 1.2m.
KLONDYKE	3THI		Fragrant golden-yellow blooms that appear in spring. The new foliage is bronze-green and shows good disease resistance. Nice autumn tones prior to leaf fall. Award of Garden Merit from the RHS. Grows approx. 1.5m x 1.5m.
LOUIE WILLIAMS			A real sweetie with softest pink blooms that have a flare of cream and delicate orange. Beautiful in very early spring. Grows approx. 1m. x 1m.
MELFORD LEMON	5THI		Butter yellow flowers in Nov. Grows approx. 1m.
MELFORD FLAME	5TG		A NZ bred Hybrid with large frilly trusses of bloom in brilliant orange tones. The blooms are lightly scented. Provides a spectacular display in spring. Fresh green summer foliage and nice autumn tones prior to leaf fall.

NICHOLAS DE ROTHCHILD	5CA		Large frilly pink and cream flowers in November. Fragrant. Grows approx. 1.5m.
PAVLOVA			Double white flowers. Grows 1.6m.
RED GEM			Red is the ideal colour to add some punch to the garden and this perfumed, deciduous Azalea will certainly do that. Luminous clear red blooms with yellow stamens make a strong statement in early spring. Grows approx. 1.2m x 1m.
SOFT LIGHTS			Enormous blooms in a soft cream shade with just a gentle glow of pastel pink. The double blooms appear in late spring. Neat and tidy habit. Fresh green summer foliage. PVR. Grows approx. 1m x 1m.
SUNRAY			Soft apricot, double flowers that appear during November. The flowers are not just easy on the eye your nose will be pleased with the delightful fragrance. Fresh green summer foliage. Grows approx. 1.5m x 1.2m.
TANGERINE POM POM			Tight pom-pom like heads of brilliant tangerine. Frilled & scented 1.8m.
VULCAN			Fragrant fire-balls of brilliant orange-red decorate this deciduous Azalea in spring just as the new foliage emerges. Use to add a 'punch' of colour to planting schemes. Can be grown in a container as long as you remember to water regularly.

WHITE ICE	7TG		The pure white flowers have a golden flare.
YELLOW BALL			Large tight heads of bright golden yellow, resembling yellow balls. Frilled & perfumed. 1.8m. (Ilam cultivar)
YELLOW BEAUTY			Large round trusses deep yellow with orange cast, and with an apricot flare. Frilled & perfumed 1.5m.

BERBERIS

BARBERRY. Come in a range of sizes, have bright spring flowers and great autumn fruits and foliage on offer. They're a good choice for low hedging or as border plants.

ATR PURPUREA	10GB		One of the least demanding and easy to grow of the deciduous barberries. A good shrub for year-round interest, it boasts dark red-purple leaves, which contrast with small, red-tinted, pale-yellow flowers in mid-spring. In autumn the leaves turn a brilliant shade of red before falling. 1.5m x 1.5m.
HELMOND PILLAR	5HA 4gb		Upright Purple Barberry is a hardy, ornamental shrub with vivid wine coloured foliage and a narrow columnar habit. Pale yellow flowers appear in mid to late spring followed by red berries that are eaten by birds. Suitable for growing in containers. Grows to about 1.5m x 60cm.
LITTLE FAVOURITE	25GB		Delightful rounded dwarf shrub with purple red leaves, and prickly stems. In autumn the leaves change to a brilliant red-orange. Very colourful. Easily grown, hardy. Deciduous. Grows 50 x 50cm.
ROSY GLOW	25GB		Japanese Barberry is a deciduous shrub with red-purple leaves, marbled pink and white. Grows to 1.5m x 1.2m. Makes a great informal hedge. Requires full sun.
THU AUREA	25GB		Also known as Golden Barberry due to the golden foliage throughout summer which then turn to shades of orange, red and yellow in autumn. Produces yellow flowers in spring, followed by red berries in autumn. Grows in either full sun or partial shade and average type soils that are moist and well-drained. Grows to approximately 1m x 1.5m.

CALYCANTHUS

Calycanthus plants are deciduous shrubs, growing to 4m tall. The plants are aromatic. The flowers lack distinct sepals and petals, but instead have spirals of tepals. It has rich, leathery, emerald, green foliage, turning to a buttery yellow in the autumn. This tree prefers semi shade although morning sun is ok and will grow to around three meters tall.

HARITIAGE WINE	5TG		Rich green, slightly glossy leaves and interesting magnolia-like flowers from early to mid-summer on the tips of short spurs with the new growth. The flowers are a rich maroon-red-brown colour, much richer than pictured. The bush requires at least half a day full sun and does best with cool roots and good drainage. It will grow to 2.5m

CHAENOMELES

FLOWERING QUINCE. These deserve more widespread plantings! They have the virtues of being very hardy, adaptable, easily pruned, and dramatically bright at a dull time of year. One of the most beautiful of early spring flowering shrubs, with the added benefit of the fruit for culinary uses. Chaenomeles standards make ideal garden focal points and super container specimens.

ALARM	9GB		Bright red flowers. Easy to grow, hardy, may be grown in either full sun or partial shade. Ideal for hedging. Grows approx 1.5m x 1.5m.
EARLY ORANGE	5GB	Japonica	Popular shrub with bright orange flowers starting from late winter and going well into spring. The edible quince fruit is fragrant and ripens in autumn. 1.5 x 1.5m
GREEN ICE			Pale green near white flowers delight in early spring on this flowering quince. Easily grown in most soils. Great in pots or a prominent garden spot. Sun. 1.5 x 0.7cm
ORANGE STORM			Produces early spring blooms of double scarlet red flowers that resemble camellias.
PINK STORM	5GS 2GB	Double Take Series	Pink flowering variety. From early spring it makes large, 4-6 cm across, semi-double, crepe-myrtle-like, pink flowers with partially frilled margins. The shrub flowers for 6-8 weeks, and what is most interesting – it keeps small growing only about a meter tall and wide. Flowers are followed by edible, pear-shaped pomes, 4-5 cm in diameter.
MRS MURPHY	5HA		Flowering Quince. Delightful dark red flowers from late winter. Ideal as a hedging or screening plant, and often used as a cut flower in winter when flowers are scarce. Prefers full sun to part shade, prune by one-third immediately after flowering to encourage new growth. 1.5m x 1m
SCARLET STORM	2GB	Double Take Series	Scarlet Storm is a medium-sized, upright to rounded, multi-stemmed shrub with a mature height of approximate 4-5 feet. It will bloom best in full sun though will tolerate some partial shade. It is an excellent spring accent plant and one of the only early spring red-blooms with eye-popping color that can be spotted from a mile away. Large, scarlet red, double flowers with velvety petals burst forth in early spring. This hybrid is fruitless and thornless. Unlike many flowering quinces, 'Scarlet Storm' tends to have flowers out to the tips of its branches. Branches with unopened flower buds can be clipped and forced to bloom for some showy indoor color. Double Take quinces often rebloom in fall for some surprising color late in the season.
YUKUKU	3HA 5GB	Japonica	Popular ornamental shrub with pure white spring blossom with tinges of green in the centre of the flower. The edible quince fruit is fragrant and ripens in autumn. 1.2 x 1.2m

CHIMONANTHUS

WINTERSWEET. Large shrub with pale green leaves. The highly scented flowers are sulphur-yellow and appear in winter. Best in a sunny site, sheltered from wind, in good loamy soil. Hardy.

COTINUS

SMOKE BUSH. Noted for their leaf colour and curious flower effects. Easy to grow, preferring an open situation and cool, free-draining, rather poor soil. Heavy winter pruning encourages annual growth renewal, a neater growing bush and better foliage display. More intense colour can be expected in areas with cold winters and dry summers, but still worth planting in milder climates.

COGGYGRIA			A small tree with striking autumn colour and a compact, bushy habit. Plumes of mauve flowers in summer, followed by brilliant autumn hues of yellow, orange and red. Trim in winter to keep compact. Deciduous. Hardy. Grows approx. 2m x 3m.
GRACE American Smoke Tree	5HA 4THI		Grown for its enormous clusters of flowers, frothy, pink panicles reach 30cm wide. In spring, leaves emerge light red, darkening through the summer to dark red. In autumn, foliage turns a mosaic of red, orange, and gold. Cotinus 'Grace' is a large excellent shrub, offering multiple seasons of interest in mixed plantings.
ROYAL PURPLE			A large shrub with rounded, deep purple leaves that get redder in autumn. Large feathery, pink inflorescences during summer. Likes partial shade or full sun and moist but well-drained soil. Grows to approximately 4m x 4m.
PURPUREA	5HA		Spectacular wine purple foliage in spring & summer turning to autumn shades of yellow, orange & red. One of the finest purple foliage shrubs or small trees. Fawny-grey flower heads over late summer look like smoke. Deciduous, hardy, grows 2.5 x 3m
VELVET CLOAK			Very beautiful, bushy deciduous shrub with dark velvety purple-red foliage. Add to this the amazing fluffy plumes of purple-pink in summer and the effect is wonderful. Easy to grow in moist, well-drained soil it can reach up to 3m x 4m.

DEUTZIA

A delightful shrub with graceful arching branches covered with delicate single pink and white flowers in spring. Compact bushy habit. Trim after flowering. Deutzia is an easy shrub to grow, tolerant of a wide range of growing conditions. The plant is tough and very hardy to frost, prefers to be planted in a sunny spot with slightly acidic, moist free draining soil.

COMPACT PINK	5GS		Easy to grow, graceful shrub with arching branches and delicate single, pink and white blooms that appear en-masse in spring. Happy in sun or part shade. Grows approx 1.5m x 1.5m.
GRACILLIS	5HA		A low-growing, deciduous shrub which forms a mound of pale green foliage in autumn. In spring, a mass of starry, white flowers appear. Lovely, fine, green foliage takes on an attractive burgundy shade in autumn. Ideal for use as a ground cover, for rockeries, and borders. Grows approximately 60cm high with a spread of 120cm.
MAGICIEN	3GB		A low-growing, deciduous shrub which forms a mound of pale green foliage in autumn. In spring, a mass of starry, white flowers appear. Lovely, fine, green foliage takes on an attractive burgundy shade in autumn. Ideal for use as a ground cover, for

			rockeries, and borders. Grows approximately 60cm high with a spread of 120cm.
NIKKO	5GS 21GB		A dense, rounded, deciduous shrub with slender, broadly spreading to arching stems. Typically grows 2-4' tall and as wide. Tiny, fragrant, bell-shaped, white flowers in spring.

EDGEWORTHIA

PAPERBUSH. Edgeworthia can be used at a woodland edge with spring bulbs and other winter flowering shrubs, mixed shrub and herbaceous border where it will provide a welcome lift early in the year. They are beautiful and fragrant plants which reward with good soil cultivation and careful placement in either full sun or partial shade.

GRANDIFLORA Yellow Daphne	5HA 2GB		The unusual pompom shaped, cream and gold flowers occur on the tips of the bare stems in August as a herald of spring. Lovely scent. Soft velvety, grey-green leaves, deciduous and hardy.

ENKIANTHUS

CAMPANULATA			Easy, trouble free shrubs for acidic soil. They're grown for their masses of delicate bell-shaped flowers that appear from mid-spring to early summer and their fiery autumnal colours. Enkianthus are ideal shrubs for an open woodland garden or shady border.

PEARL BUSH. Bushy shrubs with simple, pale green leaves and saucer-shaped, 5-petalled white flowers in terminal racemes in spring or summer.

Macrantha THE BRIDE			The Bride is a hugely popular deciduous shrub, and with good reason. In late spring and early summer it's awash with masses of pure white flowers.

FOTHERGILLA

Fothergilla is one of those rare garden shrubs grown as much for its spectacular fall foliage as it is for its showy flowers in spring. In autumn, its leaves turn every color of the fall rainbow—a breathtaking blend of orange, red, crimson, and yellow, with the display often lingering well into November.

BLUE MIST	5TG		A dense, bushy shrub with oval blue-green leaves turning bright red, orange and yellow in autumn. Cylindrical terminal fragrant flower spikes to 4cm long, of small white flowers with long stamens are borne in spring before the leaves.
MAJOR	8GB		A dense, bushy shrub with oval blue-green leaves turning bright red, orange and yellow in autumn. Cylindrical terminal fragrant flower spikes to 4cm long, of small white flowers with long stamens are borne in spring before the leaves

FORSYTHIA

A true harbinger of spring, forsythia bursts into a vibrant display of golden blooms before any leaf foliage emerges. This can create stunning golden mounds throughout landscapes, breaking up the

drab snow-covered ground with a promise of what's to come. With newer varieties growing in smaller, more manageable sizes, every landscape should have a forsythia to break out of the late winter blues.

LYNWOOD GOLD	4GB		'Lynwood Gold' is a vigorous medium-sized deciduous shrub, upright in growth, with narrowly ovate or sometimes trifoliolate leaves. Flowers relatively large, bright yellow, in early spring.
KARL SAX			A strong growing shrub. Very free flowering. Large deep canary yellow blossom. Grows 2 x 1.5m

HAMAMELIS

WITCH HAZEL - Popular for their distinctly oriental branching patterns, handsome autumn foliage and curious, spider like winter blooms. Plant in deep worked soil, rich in humus and peat moss, in full sun or partial shade with deep summer watering. Hardy.

ARNOLD PROMISE	3GB		The vase-shaped tree is as tall as it is wide, with outward growing branches that bring much needed colour during the throes of our dreary, rain-laden winter. The witch hazel's winter flush of colour and fragrance, cheer the cold right out of your bones. When the bright yellow blossoms enliven the witch hazel's branches, it is a clear signal that spring will soon explode in a riot of colour in the garden.
DIANE	3GB		Neat, upright, compact shrub that produces fragrant red blooms in late winter. The flowers are characterized by their shaggy spider like form. Plant in sun or part shade in rich soil that does not dry out in summer. 3x3m.
JELENA	2GB		Vigorous spreading habit with large ovate leaves which turn brilliant orange and red in the autumn. Flowers in dense clusters with twisted petals of yellow and coppery red.

HIBISCUS SYRIACUS

Hibiscus Syriacus is a hardy deciduous shrub. It is upright and vase-shaped, reaching 2–4m in height, bearing large trumpet-shaped flowers with prominent, yellow-tipped white stamens. The flowers are often pink in colour but can also be dark pink (almost purple), light pink or white.

RED HEART	5MIL		Easy to grow white flowering shrub will brighten your summer landscape. The deep red throats of the Red Heart Rose of Sharon (Hibiscus syriacus 'Red Heart') dot pure white blooms that hang on the upright branches of the vase shaped shrubs.
WOODBIDGE	5MIL		Also known as the Rose of Sharon or the Tree Hollyhock, its large, bright pink blooms shimmer faintly with lavender. Flowering from July and not stopping until all buds have opened, sometimes right into autumn. Fully hardy and easy to care for, this exotic-looking shrub deserves a prominent place in any garden - grow it in a large pot or in your border for a lush, tropical feel.

HYDRANGEA

Easy to grow, adaptable to most conditions but do best with dappled afternoon shade and plenty of water when it's hot & dry. Colours range from white, cream, blue and pink. **MOPHEADS:** Large heads of blossoms, they are showy, easy care and bloom reliably every summer.

LACECAP: Similar to the mophead but instead of growing round clusters of showy blossoms will grow flowers that resemble flat caps with frilly edges. The flower is a round disk of short flowers, edged with showier flowers.

PANICLE: Known for their long panicles from which their large flowers bloom. Their flowers will first appear as white, but as the plant grows older, the flowers may turn pink. Cold hardy and flower from mid to late summer with long lasting flowers that are great for cut flowers.

To ensure flowers remain blue plant in acid soil or treat with Aluminium Sulphate.

To ensure a beautiful shade of pink apply lime or superphosphate fertiliser.

WHEN TO PRUNE HYDRANGEAS: PANICULATA & ARBORESCEN VARIETIES: Late winter before growth begins. MOPHEAD, LACECAP, OAKLEAF & CLIMBING VARIETIES: After bloom in summer. Two fat buds means next year's flowers. Two small buds means leaf buds.

AGNES PAVELLI	10HA 1GB	Mophead	Considered to be one of the best of the mopheads. Tidy bush which is covered in neat domes of pure white flowers with clean smooth-edged sepals. Ideal for coastal plantings, and full sun. Good for dried flowers. Doesn't scorch as quickly as most other whites. 1.5m x 2.5m.
ANNABELLE	10HA 10MIL 16GB	LG	Stunning white hydrangea. Huge pure white balls. Grow in moist, well-drained moderately fertile, humus rich soil. Grows 2.5 x 2.5m
AYESHA	10HA		Large mophead flowers with individual florets which are similar to lilac in form and with a soft fragrance. Depending on soil they will flowers a soft pink or light blue. Grows to about 2m. A real beauty which copes with sun and wind. Deciduous
BLAUMEISE	10HA		Stunning Hydrangea with large flat flower heads made up of deep blue florets that surround the tiny central flowers that are in turn a deeper shade of blue. Nice glossy green foliage sets the flowers off. Plant in morning sun or semi-shade in rich acid soil. Deciduous.
BLOODY MARVELLOUS (Raspberry Crush)	10HA 10MIL 5GB	LG	For description refer Raspberry Crush
BLUEBERRIES & CREAM	7GB		Dramatic blue/white lace cap flowers cover the whole bush all season. Perfect for patio containers and gardens in single and massed plantings. Suitable to a wide range of soils. Prefers a partially shaded position. Cut foliage back to 2-3 pairs of buds in late winter. Deciduous. Height 1.2m.
BLUE DECKLE	10HA 6GB	Lacecap	Soft powder blue florets that highlight the central head of smaller blue flowers. Nice compact growth habit Grows approx 1.5m x 1.5m.
BLUE DIAMOND	10HA	Mophead	Genuine compact dwarf grower. Large tight heads of cornflower blue. Ideal for pots and tubs. Grows to 80cm.

BLUE PRINCE	10HA	Mophead	One of the hardiest hydrangeas. It is of moderate height with dense medium blue flowers in an acid soil, and ranges from pink to purple in neutral soil. This deciduous, rounded shrub has ovate, toothed green leaves to 8 inches long. Enormous flower clusters to 20cm across bloom in summer and early autumn.
BLUE WAVE	17GB	Lacecap	Flowers in shades of blue florets that are almost flat. Prefers partial shade and grows up to 1 metre in both height and width. Give an occasional side dressing of Aluminium Sulphate to help maintain the blue colour.
BOMBSHELL	16GB	Dwarf Paniculata Grandiflora	Creamy white flowers age green from early summer well into autumn. Thrives in sun or part shade and is great for containers & smaller gardens.
BRIDAL BOUQUET	20HA 20GS 2GB	Mophead	A good choice for a summer bridal bouquet. Gorgeous large white flower heads that open from soft lime green buds. Lovely to pick. Best planted in dappled light and soil that does not completely dry out in summer.
BRILLIANT	10HA 1GB	Mophead	Medium to dwarf size. Rich carmine red flower heads brighten up the shrubbery or flowering border with this Hydrangea that has large round heads of carmine red flowers from summer to autumn. Happiest in morning sun or part shade in nice fertile soil that does not completely dry out in summer. To maintain the carmine-red colour of the blooms side dress annually with Lime.
CANDLELIGHT	5CON 6GB	Paniculata	A stunning, hardy, deciduous, rounded shrub with dark red, upright growing stems and produces cream-white conical flowers in summer that gradually turn pink as they age and having good autumn foliar colour too, an outstanding feature plant for the garden. May be grown in full sun or light shade where soils are fertile, reasonably moist and free-draining. Typically grows to about 1.5m both in height and width.

DIAMOND ROUGE	5GS 1GB	Paniculata	This brilliant Hydrangea is the reddest of all Hydrangea Paniculata varieties. During early summer it unfurls very large heads of white flowers. These flowers gradually turn pink and as summer moves into autumn a spectacular purple shaded red. It is quite dwarf growing at 120cm tall by 80cm wide.
FIREWORKS	10HA	Lacecap	Unusual and Marvellous Hydrangea. It is a vigorous and flowers profusely. The 'Fireworks' name relates to the pure white flowers each is like an exploding firework! Pale pink and then opening white with jagged edges! Both dazzling and elegant at the same time. Thrives in partial shade in needs moist soil.
FLOWER MASTER BLUE	5SS	Mophead	Dark blue Likes to be grown in partial shade with moist, free draining soil. A hardy, deciduous shrub that would benefit from the occasional top dressing of Aluminium Sulphate to help maintain its colour. Grows to about 1m x 1m.
FLOWER MASTER RED		Mophead	Dark red colour. Prefers partial shade in moist, well-drained soil. Hardy, deciduous shrub growing to approximately 1.2m.
GEOFFREY CHAUBAUND	10HA 4GB	Lacecap	Improved European lacecap type. Attractive red heads. Turns spirarea-red in alkaline or slightly acid soils. Grows to 1.5m.

GOLDIE	10HA 2GB		Noted for it bright yellow, lime green foliage, stunning in a dappled light to semi shade position. Lovely pink or white flowers.
GRANDAD	20HA	Mophead	Enormous 50cm pure white flowers with lush green leaves. This is one of the most striking hydrangeas for sheer size of the flower. A hardy deciduous plant with large lush leaves and enormous 50cm pure white flowers in summer. 1m x 1m.
GRAYSWOOD	10HA	Lacecap	Attractive tall shrub with large. Flowers have blue fertile florets encircled by white sterile ray florets that gradually turn rose and finally deep carmine red. Superb! Bonus of great autumn colour. 1.8m x 1.5m.

KOLKWITZIA

BEAUTY BUSH. Forms a dense, multi-branched shrub with its uppermost stems gracefully arching. Oval, long pointed leaves, 5-8cm dull green and slightly hairy. During late spring and early summer the graceful drooping stems and branches are completely draped with masses of 15mm bell shaped, 5 lobed flowers resembling abelia or weigela blooms. Buds bright rosy pink, open flowers pink on the outside with orange throat and dots inside, followed by conspicuous pinky brown, bristly egg shaped fruits which prolong the display of colour. Locate in average, well drained soil in full sun.

PINK CLOUD

The common name for this plant is 'Beauty Bush' and the botanical 'amabilis' means lovely so you know that this is just a beautiful flowering shrub. Bell shaped pink blooms drape the arching branches from late spring to early summer. Flaky bark that peels off in winter. Grows approx 2m x 2m.

LAGERSTROEMIA

CREPE MYRTLE. A versatile and showy specimen tree. Crepe Myrtles are an upright deciduous tree or large shrub that have dark green leaves emerging bronze. The crinkled flowers, hence the name "crepe", appear from summer to autumn in shades of white, pink, red or purple.

Crepe Myrtles require moderately fertile, well-drained soil. Best planted in a warm sheltered position.

SAMBA	5GS		Very pale lilac coloured flowers from about mid-summer. Has brilliant autumn colour as foliage turns to various shades of orange, red and yellow. Likes full sun and well-drained soil and grows approx 80cm.
TANGO	5GS		This is a dwarf crepe myrtle that produces purple flowers in the summer. It has lime-green leaves in the spring that mature to green in the summer before turning brilliant shades of red, orange, and yellow in the autumn. 1m x 0.5m.

BRIDAL WREATH: Popular for their hardiness, free flowering, graceful habit and pleasing foliage, they are easy to grow and require little in the way of maintenance apart from the occasional thinning and pruning to keep vigour and shape. Generally tolerant of extremes of heat and cold. Use them to emphasise the colour of spring bulbs or annuals planted underneath them and their blooms are popular for cut flowers.

SNOWBERRY, WAXBERRY OR GHOSTBERRY. From the honeysuckle family. Very resilient – can withstand a variety of conditions. Most commonly found in forests, dry or moist openings, rocky hillsides or near riverbanks and streams. They grow in a range of soil types and sunlight conditions.

MOTHER OF PEARL

2GB

A charming deciduous shrub that is highly valued for the white, flushed pink, marble like berries which weigh down the branches from autumn to winter. Gorgeous for floral decoration. Hardy and easy to grow in the sun or part shade. Green foliage in spring-summer. Deciduous.

SYRINGA

LILAC. Usually grown for its intense fragrance and beautiful blooms and for adding a good source of privacy or shade when planted as a hedge. If planting more than one bush space them at least 1.5m apart to prevent overcrowding (even when planted for a hedge). Choose a spot that gets plenty of afternoon sun and that has well drained soil.

ALICE EASTWOOD

5CAV

Beautiful buds of claret purple open to bright cyclamen pink, double blooms in mid spring. The clusters of flowers are beautifully formed and fragrant. Nice to pick. Plant in sun to light shade in deep well worked soil. Side dress with lime occasionally. Grows approx 2.5m x 1.5m.

BELLE NANCY

5CAV

Large stunning panicles of double bloom open to soft cyclamen pink in October and waft their fragrance through the air. Picks well so bring some inside to enjoy. Plant in sun to light shade in deep well worked soil. Side dress with lime occasionally. Deciduous.

CONGO

5CAV

Commonly known as Lilac but there is nothing common about this lovely spring flowering lilac. Delicious panicles of deep mauve single blooms with a reddish hue and a delightful fragrance. Happy in sun or part shade in deeply worked soil. Side dress with Lime annually. Deciduous. Any pruning should be done immediately after flowering.

CHARLES JOLLY

5CAV

Considered to be the best double lilac. Delightfully scented trusses of double plum red blossom in late spring. A superior cut flower variety. 2.5 X 1.5m

CLARKS GIANT

5CAV

Tight rosy pink buds open to reveal racemes of pretty single lilac blooms. Delightful perfume in spring. Plant in sun or part shade in deeply worked soil. Side dress with Lime annually. Deciduous. Grows: 2.5m x 1.5m.

CONDORCET

Large panicles of double lavender blooms. Beautiful fragrance. Lilacs like sun or dappled shade, deeply worked soil and a side dressing of Lime annually. Any pruning should be done immediately after flowering. Grows approx 3m

DOUBLE PURPLE

The double, dark purple flowers have a pale lilac throat. Grows to approx 2-3m

Double claret, pink buds opening to a lighter shade. Early flowering. 2.5 X 1.5m

5CAV

Lilac. Tight red buds open to reveal panicles of large soft rose pink single flowers. Very generous with bloom that will fill your spring garden with a rich fragrance. Happy in sun or part shade

VIBURNUM

Viburnums are fabulous in the garden for many reasons – they always look neat and tidy, often smell good and don't crave constant attention. This genus of evergreen and deciduous shrubs are great background performers and should not be overlooked when planning a new garden or refurbishing an existing planting scheme.

Viburnums are tolerant of just about any soil but they are happiest in a rich humus that does not completely dry out in summer. If you choose carefully you can have Viburnums in flower from

winter through to the end of summer. The flowers are often sweetly scented and are followed by very attractive ornamental berries. The deciduous varieties have excellent autumn leaf colour. Viburnums can be kept tidy by cutting back any straggly older shoots after flowering. You won't find this an arduous task and if you decide not to do it your Viburnum will still perform well for you.

Most are frost hardy with the exception of *Viburnum odoratissimum* "Emerald Lustre" which will only tolerate a light frost. If you do have a frost free area this is a wonderful plant to add a lush tropical look as it has large rounded glossy green foliage with a hint of bronze. Some Viburnums are prone to attack from thrips in summer, especially *Viburnum tinus* varieties such as "Eve Price" and "Gwenllian" but this is easily controlled (see care instructions on Rhododendron page) and should not detract from their overall value.

Flower clusters appear in two rows or files, umbels have a lace cap effect (small, non-showy, inner fertile flowers with a showy outer ring of sterile flowers). Fertile flowers give way in late summer to orange-red, berry-like drupes which mature to black. Reddish to bronze-purple fall colour. Fruits, flowers and autumn foliage colour may all be simultaneously present on plants in early fall. Grows approx 1.3m X 1.3m.

WEIGELIA

Old-fashioned beauty, tough, low maintenance & hardy. Plant in a sunny spot and allow room for it to grow (including roots). A top performing, easy to grow, spring flowering shrub that deserves a place in the border or shrubbery. Plant in a sunny spot and prune after flowering.

APPLEBLOSSOM	14GB		With its unusual columnar habit 'Apple Blossom' does exactly as its name suggests. The pale pink blooms are borne along the entire length of each stem, creating a pillar of blooms in early summer, and often a few more in late summer as an added bonus! The oval shaped foliage is bronzed as it emerges but later matures to dark green.
