GRAPE VINES

ALBANY SURPRISE Ripens March – mid to late season.	10MA 5INC		Heavy crops of medium sized bunches of large juicy aromatic and spicy berries with a jelly texture. The skin is jet black. Hardy and disease resistant. Vigorous. Reliable outdoor variety. Makes a nice wine. Self fertile. Deciduous.
BLACK HAMBURG			Has large black berries of a delicious, sweet flavour, can be eaten fresh from the vine. A later maturing variety with good disease resistance.
BUFFALO	5INC		Considered by those in the know to have the highest dessert (eating) quality of the early black grapes. The berries are slipskin, juicy, very sweet, spicy and tart. Also makes a candy-like ruby red wine. Self fertile. Deciduous.
CANADICE Ripens late February	15INC		Excellent tasting with mild Lubrusca flavour. Thin skinned red berry maturing mid-season. Moderate to heavy crops. Disease resistant. Mid Season.
FLAME SEEDLESS			An attractive round and sweet seed less grape. Medium sized light red berries. Early to mid-season ripening. Heavy cropper.
HIMROD	10INC		A vigorous deciduous vine with bold-textured, deep green foliage. Grown for its clusters of small, entirely seedless, crispy sweet, early season fruit that turns golden yellow when fully ripe in the summer. Works well for use as an ornamental vine on an arbor or trellis or trailing along fences. Excellent for fresh eating as a sweet dessert grape.
KYOHO			Grown and prized in Japan for their huge size and very sweet flesh. A blackish-purple variety with high sugar content which is complimented by their moderate acidity. Self fertile. Deciduous.
LAKEMONT SEEDLESS	25INC		Lakeland is a seedless medium sweet green/white table grape that has an excellent flavour. It ripens March to early April and is resistant to downy mildew
IONA Ripens late February	5HA		Heavy crops of sweet pinkish skin medium sized fruit with high resistance to downy mildew. Regular & reliable cropper. Uniform bunches. Suited to coastal conditions. Self fertile. Deciduous. Mid season.
MOORES DIAMOND			White flesh and skin make this an ideal table grape. Reputed to be one of the best dry, but fruity white sparkling wine. A good variety for growing under glass. Ripening around mid March. Resistant to fungal attacks. Self fertile. Deciduous
NIAGARA	5INC 5HA		Popular green gold, sweet, juicy grape with sharp tangy flavour. Thin skin and low seed content. Ripens March or mid season. Vigorous and very healthy grower bearing large clusters of fruit in mid season.

ROBINSON	5HA		A Black Hamburg type. Large sweet, black grapes. Long producing giving high yields. Self fertile. Deciduous.
PINOT GRIS			An early-ripening quality white grape. Sometimes producing dark-blue grapes rather than the normal grayish-blue berry. Yields reasonably well. Retains low to fair acidity and a high sugar level. A late harvester. Good for cool climates.
PINOT NOIR			A premium quality reddish-black grape. Gives moderate yields of fine wine with considerable softness, depth and elegance. Colour is developed early. Grows best in areas warm days and cool nights.
SCHUYLER Ripens early February	5INC 3THI		Early Season. Medium sized bunches of blue-black non-slip skin, with large clusters and good yields. Super rich burgundy leaves in autumn. Regular heavy cropper. Self fertile. Deciduous.
STUBEN Ripens March. (mid to late season)			Reddish-black grape, producing long tapering, compact clusters which are among the most attractive of all fresh market cultivars. Sweet with a distinctive spicy tang. Hardy, vigorous, productive, disease resistant. Easily grown. Good autumn colours Self fertile. Deciduous.
THOMPSONS SEEDLESS GRAFTED			Famous commercial selection and mainstay of the Californian table grape industry. Large clusters of pale green gold, very sweet, seedless berries. Needs plenty of heat and best with a spray program. Later ripening. Self fertile. Deciduous.
RUBYS SEEDLESS			Large clusters of small to medium seedless, red to reddish-black berries. Sweet eating fruit. Ripens late midseason. Self fertile. Deciduous.
SAUVIGNON BLANC			A premium white grape. Produces wines of fine quality (dry or Sweet) with considerable depth and complexity. The grape ripens with fair acidity sometimes with quite high sugar content, fine aroma, and flavour. Generally, small and tight bunches are produced.
URBANA			Good crops cherry red berries, with exquisite sweet Lubrusca flavour, jelly texture. Vine is vigorous and disease resistant
WHITE DIAMOND			A disease resistant white grape that shows adaptability to soils and climates. The flavour is mild and sweet. The vines have an upright habit that makes them easy to train, and their vigour is sufficient without being excessive. Late summer ripening. Self-fertile.
