Membership Benefits

Being a Member of Buckinghamshire Craft Guild is an excellent opportunity to meet and collaborate with other makers. As a member-led organisation, there are plenty of opportunities to learn new skills and increase professional confidence. Guild Members benefit from being able to showcase their work and offer it for sale in the Guild's Gallery at Layby Farm in Stoke Mandeville and on the online shop.

Membership Criteria

- 1. Applicant lives or works in/near Buckinghamshire.
- 2. Work is high-quality, contemporary and design led.
- 3. Work is predominantly hand-crafted or of a one-off nature if manufactured.
- 4. Work may be any form of contemporary craft including ceramics, glass, furniture, jewellery, metal, printmaking, textiles, wood or willow, organic or recycled materials and mixed media. We do not stock paintings, photographs or digital art. All prints need to be original.
- 5. Applicant should demonstrate that they have relevant creative experience and a professional approach to their work.
- 6. Applicant should be able to staff the Gallery for a minimum of one day per month (or 2 half days), be happy to deal with the public and be able to present and sell their own and other Members' work and to offer demonstrations. Guidance and support on sales and Gallery procedures will be provided. Where possible the Gallery is staffed by two Members.
- 7. Members display work in the Gallery throughout the year and are responsible for keeping their stock up to date so that it represents the best of their current work and is refreshed regularly.

- 8. All Members play an active role in supporting and promoting the aims of the Guild. For example, to facilitate workshops and outings for Members, external exhibitions and marketing/promotion.
- **9.** The Guild Board is made up of Members and oversees operational processes. Membership of the Board is on a rotational basis for any Members who are interested in joining.

Application Process

Please complete and return your form and supporting documents by email to membership@buckinghamshirecraftguild.co.uk.

Your application will be acknowledged and then reviewed by a selection of current Members and feedback provided.

Short-listed Applicants will be invited to an interview at the Gallery with a panel of three to five Members cross-discipline, normally including a Member working in the same medium as yourself. You will be asked to bring in some pieces of your work to discuss with the panel.

Following the interview, feedback will be provided, normally by email. Successful Applicants will then be invited to join Buckinghamshire Craft Guild.

Membership Packages

We offer four different packages depending on the number of days per month you would like to staff the Gallery.

Opening hours: 10am to 4pm. Tue to Sat, 12 noon to 4pm Sun. Closed Mondays. Members must be able to staff the Gallery occasional weekends.
