

### Rules of Play:

- The lottery will take place from September 18, 2020 to September 25, 2020 online at [ontariomedicalfoundation50-50.ca](http://ontariomedicalfoundation50-50.ca).
- All tickets will only be sold to people who are 18 years of age or older.
- Tickets for the 50-50 for Ontario Medical Foundation Virtual Gala will be sold as follows:
  - 5 tickets for \$10.00
  - 20 tickets for \$20.00
  - 100 tickets for \$50.00
- Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle system supplied by Canadian Bank Note.
- The draw dates will take place on:
  - Main 50/50 draw: September 25, 2020 at the Ontario Medical Foundation. Ticket purchases must be made no later than 10:00pm on September 25, 2020 in order to be eligible for this main 50/50 draw.
- After buying, patrons will be given by the sellers a receipt with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly.
- The winning ticket number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw.
- The amount of the 50/50 will be monitored on website, and will be 50% of the total sales for that draw.
- The winning number will be announced on website, and in print on site.
- The winner will also be contacted directly by a representative from the Ontario Medical Foundation by phone and/or email.
- The winner may claim their prize by contacting the Ontario Medical Foundation at: 416-340-2259, or by email at: [omf@oma.org](mailto:omf@oma.org). The ticket may then be brought to 150 Bloor Street West, Suite 900, Toronto, ON M5S 3C1, at an agreed upon time for ticket verification. The winner will then be awarded the prize amount by cheque. Winners must have the original winning ticket and no copies. All payments will be made by cheque.
- The winning ticket holder has 6 months in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchased for.
- The winner must provide photo identification and verify their phone number and address in order to claim their prize.

- Once the certified winner is verified, and provides identification with photo ID, they will be given a cheque in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that draw. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.
- In the event that no winner comes forward, the winning stub will be kept in a safety deposit box and held for 6 months. After that time period has elapsed, the prize will be donated back to the Ontario Medical Foundation, with the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO.)
- Ticket purchasers must be located in the province of Ontario at the time of purchase.
