It is one of the most popular movie dinosaurs.

VELOCIRAPTOR

The Velociraptor had hollow bones like a bird, making it fast and lightweight.

UTAHRAPTOR

The Utahraptor is the largest raptor yet discovered. About 25 feet from head to tail.

The claws on their hind feet were almost a foot long.

TRICERATOPS

The name Triceratops means three-horned face.

They had an enormous skull that was one-third of its body.

ANKYLOSAURUS

The top speed of an Ankylosaurus was only up to 6 miles per hour.

Ankylosaurus had many protective and defensive features which lead it to being called "a living tank".

TYRANNOSAURUS REX

The name Tyrannosaurus Rex means Tyrant Lizard
The largest T. Rex tooth found is 12 inches long

PARASAUROLOPHUS

Parasaurolophus had large head crests they used for trumpeting.

You pronounce their name PARA-SAW-ROL-OFUS

SPINOSAURUS

The Spinosaurus was the largest carnivorous dinosaur.

They weighed up to 20 tons which is about 3 elephants!

PTERODACTYL

The Pterodactyl had an elongated beack with about 90 razor sharp teeth.

A young Pterodactyl is called a flapling.

STEGOSAURUS

The Stegosaurus had brains the size of ping pong balls and are often referred to as the dumbest dinosaur.

Their name means roofed lizard.
