Tocopheryl Acetate	It's the most commonly used version of pure vitamin E in cosmetics.	<u> </u>
Aloe Barbadensis Leaf (Aloe Vera) Extract	A magic plant! The extract coming from the juice of the Aloe vera plant. Has moisturizing, emollient and anti-inflammatory properties as the juice itself.	Goodie
