HOW TO BAKE

1x RECTANGLE	1 & 1/2 PACKETS (975g)	50 MINUTES
1x CYLINDER	1/2 PACKET (325g) (USE THE LEFTOVER CAKE MIX FROM THE RECTANGLE CAKE)	30 MINUTES
1x CUBE	1 PACKET (650g)	50 MINUTES

HOW TO ASSEMBLE

1. CUT THE ROUNDED TOPS OFF ALL THREE CAKES AND TURN THEM UPSIDE DOWN SO THE CUT SIDE IS DOWN.
2. CUT THE RECTANGLE CAKE IN HALF, LENGTHWISE, TO CREATE TWO THIN RECTANGLE CAKES.
3. PLACE THE TWO THIN RECTANGLE CAKES ONTO YOUR CAKE BOARD, PARALLEL TO EACH OTHER AND WITH A GAP IN THE MIDDLE OF APPROXIMATELY 4CM.
4. PLACE THE CUBE CAKE ON TOP OF THE RECTANGLE CAKE.
5. CUT THE CYLINDER CAKE IN HALF DOWN THE MIDDLE. PLACE ONE HALF IN FRONT OF THE RECTANGLE CAKES. THIS WILL FORM THE BUCKET OF THE DIGGER.

YOU WILL NEED

1. 3 PACKET CAKE MIXES
2. SHAPE TINS DIGGER DECORATING SET
3. YELLOW/ FOOD COLOURING
4. TV SNACKS, CRUNCHIE BAR, JUBES

HOW TO DECORATE

1. MAKE ICING ACCORDING TO THE INSTRUCTIONS ON THE PACKET.
2. ADD A FEW DROPS OF YELLOW/ FOOD COLOURING TO THE ICING AND MIX THROUGH.
3. ICE THE ENTIRE CAKE.
4. CUT OUT THE EDIBLE PAPER DESIGNS. REMOVE THE PLASTIC BACKING AND PLACE ONTO THE ICED CAKE. USING OUR IMAGE AS A GUIDE.
5. ADD TV SNACKS ALONG EACH OF THE THIN RECTANGLE CAKES, USING OUR IMAGE AS A GUIDE.
6. ADD ANY ADDITIONAL DECORATIONS THAT YOU WOULD LIKE. WE HAVE USED A CRUSHED CRUNCHIE BAR TO REPRESENT DIRT AND JUBES FOR LIGHTS.
7. FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS ON THE PAPER CUT-OUTS TO ASSEMBLE THE DIGGER ARM, SET IT ASIDE. SHORTLY BEFORE THE PARTY, POSITION THE DIGGER ARM ON THE CAKE. USING OUR IMAGE AS A GUIDE.
