## Post-operative information for patients in Day Surgery Unit

## Hysteroscopy and Curettage / Endometrial Ablation

- 1. You may experience some bleeding or brownish discharge lasting a few days to a week. If there is heavier bleeding please contact Dr Rosen. Once the discharge ceases you may swim, take baths etc. Showers are perfectly fine immediately post-op.
- 2. Sexual intercourse is safe whenever you feel appropriate after the second post-operative day.
- 3. If appropriate, your next period may be early or late and usually a bit heavier than normal. This is normal. You may use pads or tampons
- 4. Over 50% of patients experience no post-operative discomfort. If you do, it may be a period-like pain. Ponstan or Naprogesic, sold over the counter, is the best medication for this.
