Teakwood Accent Walls Recommended Care Instructions

Your teakwood accent wall is easy to maintain, as long as you avoid cleaning it in an inappropriate manner. In fact, in most cases, less is more. Teak is an extremely resilient wood that generally cares for itself.

To clean your InspiredWall, go over it with a soft nylon tipped cleaning brush. This is the safest and surest way to dust and clean your teakwood panels. And that's it!

Note that if you choose to expose your teakwood panels to the elements, they will age naturally over the years to a pleasing and distinctive shade of silvery gray. This is the color most associated with teak.

CAUTION: Applying teak oil to genuine teakwood is a short-term solution that creates longer-term problems. Products marketed as "teak oil" are not made from anything that's extracted from a teak tree but rather linseed or tung oils with some varnish and thinners. Applying teak oil is not recommended.
