### ABOUT YOUR DECAL

## **Transfer Tape**

Used to easily apply the decal to your surface. Is translucent and has adhesive on one side.



# Backing Paper


Secures the decal during shipping. Is a thicker paper and has a waxy coating

# Vinyl Decal

The only piece you want to keep. Will be the color vinyl you selected in your order.

### 1. Clean the box thoroughly with rubbing alcohol

The vinyl will not stick to dirty, oily or wet surfaces. Ensure your mailbox is clean and dry before applying. Mailboxes can have oils on the surface, so we highly recommend wiping the surface with alcohol. Make sure the box is dry before proceeding.



Follow steps 3-5 to apply the heart, then repeat with the mailbox decal once you are ready. If the heart does not adhere firmly, your surface may not be properly prepared. You may remove the practice heart before you apply the other decals.

#### Remove the backing paper

Place the decal face down. Rub the back with a credit card, squeegee, spatula or other hard, flat object to ensure the decal adheres to the masking layer. If your decal was packaged in a tube, you may need to allow it to flatten out before beginning the application.

Slowly peel the backing paper away from the decal to remove it. If the decal begins to come up with the backing, simply lay the backing back down and apply additional pressure to the backing before continuing.





Peel the backing from the top corner Pull downwards towards the opposite corner

#### 4. Apply the decal to your mailbox

Carefully place the decal on your mailbox surface. Stick the top of the decal and work your way down and out, lightly rubbing with your hands.

Apply significant pressure to the decal using your tool. PRESS HARD.



#### 5. Remove the transfer tape

Slowly remove the transfer tape pulling downwards from the top right corner. DO NOT pull it towards you as it may pull the decal from the mailbox. Gently tug down at a 45 degree angle until the transfer tape is removed. If the decal begins to come up with the tape, simply place it back and apply more rubbing pressure before proceeding.
