


Quick Setup Guide *...then keep this sheet in your User Guide Pack for reference.*

Unpacking the machine

You will find the consumables for the machine in the top of the box - remove them and set them aside.

Take note of how the machine is packaged in case you need to repackage it at any time.



 Please keep all packaging in case the machine needs to be returned at any point.

Installing the consumables

Install the Repair Credit Chip:

Before switching on the machine install the Credit Chip in the socket at the front left of the machine.



Install the Polish & Water:

Fill the water bottle to the 250ml line (normal tap water is fine) and install the tube, making sure it goes all the way to the bottom of the bottle. The water bottle goes in the right hand side of the compartment as you look at the back of the machine.

Next, install one of the polish bottles into the left hand side of the compartment. First, remove the safety seal from underneath the bottle cap and then insert the tube through the cap hole. Make sure the tube goes all the way to the bottom of the bottle.



Now plug in and switch on the machine - this will load the credit and the lid will open automatically.

Install the Pads & Centre Hub:

Each pad is marked either "L" - left, or "R" - right. Take one of each and attach them to a corresponding velcro pad holder.

Now take one of the rubber Centre Hubs and slide it onto the hexagonal centre shaft as far as it will go.

Jet Nozzle Extenders

The Jet Nozzle Extenders allow polish to get closer to the disc, resulting in a more effective repair. In addition, they are removable, enabling you to rub them between your fingers to clear any dried polish.



 Please ensure the Jet Nozzle Extenders are correctly fitted to the nozzles.

Priming the polish & water pipes



1. Place a piece of tissue under the nozzles to catch the excess
2. Press the "W" button to start priming the water.
3. Press "W" again when water starts to drip out of the Water Nozzle.
4. Now press the "C" button to start priming polish.
5. Press "C" again when polish begins to drip out of the Polish Nozzle.

Your machine is now primed and ready to start repairing. Switch it off if you wish - but leave the lid open because closing it will begin the repair process.

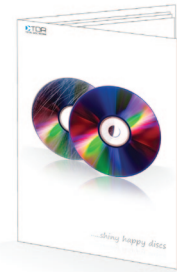
