A Multilayered Forest
 Welcome to the Amazon! Here, the trees are really tall! There are many layers in the forest, and each animal has adapted well to the layer that is its home.

The Emergent Layer

The tallest trees in the rain forest are about 200 feet (60 meters) above the forest floor. Animals who live in this layer can fly or move very quickly.

Treetops are ideal places for birds to perch.

A hairy eagle swoops toward its prey, a monkey.

The Canopy

This is the rain forest's main layer and is like a roof for the two layers below it. There's a lot of food here.

The Understory

The coati is an excellent climber. During the day it looks for food on the treetops. At night it sleeps in reetops.

The anaconda is one of the largest snakes in the world. It can grow to more than 30 feet (9 meters).

The toucan breaks open fruit with its large beak.

The armadillo comes out of its burrow at night to look for insects to eat.

Tarantulas are large, hairy spiders. Some of them are poisonous.

Termites build a huge home called a termite mound.

The anaconda is the longest, lightest, and thickest snake in the world.

Leaf litter and other fallen parts of plants help grow the fungus that they eat.
