



## Uneek Swing Tank Top

Designed for Urth Yarns

### Materials:

1 Skein Color A Urth Uneek Fingering  
1 Skein Color B Urth Uneek Fingering

**Size:** One Size, straps are adjustable, see diagram

**Needles:** US Size 8

**Notions:** Ten buttons 1" in diameter

**Gauge:** 18 sts x 26 rows in stockinette = 4" square

### Abbreviations:

BO - Bind off

CO - Cast on

K - Knit

K2tog - Knit 2 stitches together

Rep - Repeat

Sts - Stitches

YO - Yarn over

### Special Stitch Patterns:

Stockinette Stitch - knit one row purl one row

Garter Stitch - knit every row

### Pattern Notes:

This piece is knit sideways beginning with the right front button band.

Color Repeats are formed by alternating two sets of 14 rows stockinette stitch framed in a four stitch garter ridge, referred to herein as Pattern A, with 16 rows of garter stitch short rows, referred to herein as Pattern B, in the two different colorways as indicated in the pattern.

When turning the work the knitter may prefer to use a wrap and turn rather than a simple "turn" as written. A "turn" will result in a small eyelet hole at each turn whereas a "wrap and turn" creates a tighter junction point and is picked up when the wrapped stitch is knit.

To make a wider bodice, increase the pattern repeats of Pattern A and B evenly in the appropriate color.

### Pattern:

#### Button Band Front Right Bodice

CO 78 sts with Color A

Row 1-8: Knit

#### First half of Bodice from Right front to center of Back

Pattern A: Color A

Row 1: K 78





Row 2: K 4, p 70, k 4  
Rows 3-14: Rep rows 1-2

Pattern B: Color B  
Row 1: K14 and turn  
Row 2: K14  
Row 3: K24 and turn  
Row 4: K24  
Row 5: K34 and turn  
Row 6: K34  
Row 7: K44 and turn  
Row 8: K44  
Row 9: K54 and turn  
Row 10: K54  
Row 11: K64 and turn  
Row 12: K64  
Row 13: K74 and turn  
Row 14: K74  
Rows 15-16: K78

Repeat Pattern A and Pattern B seven times.

Work Pattern A in color A

This completes the bodice from the button band around to the center of the back.

#### Second half of bodice from Center of Back to Button Holes on Left Front

Repeat Pattern A with Color B

Repeat Pattern B in Color A

Repeat Pattern A and Pattern B seven times.

Work Pattern A with Color B

This completes the bodice from the middle of the back to the buttonhole band on the front left.

#### Buttonhole Band Front Left

Rows 1-3: Knit

Row 4: K3, \*yo, k2tog, k10\* 6x, yo, k3.

Rows 5-8: Knit

BO

#### Straps (Make two)

CO 8 sts

Row 1-3:K

Row 4: K3, yo, k2tog, k3

Rep Rows 1 - 4

Continue in garter stitch until work measures 9.75"/25cm

Rep row 4

Rep rows 1-3

Rep row 4

Rep rows 1-3

BO

**Finishing:**

Weave in all loose ends.

On button band align buttons to the six buttonholes on the buttonhole band.

Sew six buttons to front button band using coordinated thread or Uneck yarn.

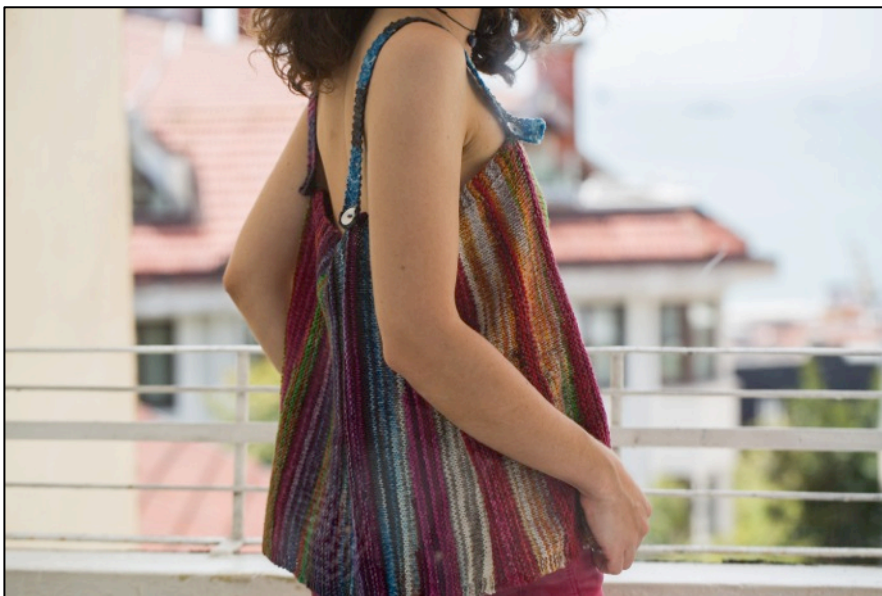
Align button on front left to suit preferred placement of front left strap.

Align button on back left to suit preferred placement of back left strap.

Repeat for right side.

Button straps to bodice.

Enjoy your new swing tank.



**Dimensions:**

Straps Measured flat: 12"/30.5cm x 1.25"/3.3cm with a total of four button holes

Bodice Measured flat buttoned:

Width at top: 17"/43cm

Length:15"/28cm

Width at bottom: 26"/66cm

Bodice dimensions when laid out unbuttoned, short rows form a gentle arch to the top and bottom to form a conical rather than rectangular shape to enhance the sway of the fabric when worn:
