
Cuba & Angola

Part of "The Cuban Revolution in World Politics" series, Cuba & Angola delivers a trove of articles, speeches and writings from, among others, Fidel Castro, Raúl Castro and Nelson Mandela, divided into five chapters. The fifteen authored pieces, plus one article setting the Cuba's background and interest in the region.



The content makes for interesting reading and the perspectives delivered in the words of key players in the political and military actions up until about 1991 offer insight into policies and decisions were driving the times.

The book does not pretend to offer a balanced historical look at Angola and Southwest Africa during the war there, but the format—their words, not a historian's—gives authenticity to the work.
