Malcolm X was one of the most important revolutionary figures of the twentieth century. He fought for African American rights during the 1960s and brought the issue into the world's conscience, a societal shift which remains long after his tragic assassination in 1965. Perry presents this collection of six Malcolm X speeches and interviews which have never been published before. Including two of his last speeches before his assassination, this collection illuminates Malcolm X's political and revolutionary stances during the last weeks of his life.
