For sizeable, multifaceted collections of literature pertaining to the history of U.S. Socialism, a sampler of Debs' speeches and writings reprinted from numerous sources. The sources reflect Debs' basic tenets and his views or stands on issues or events within America's divided labor movement, on matters of Socialist Party politics and tactics, and affairs affecting the entire U.S. at its threatened entry into World War I, which Debs opposed. The book's socialist editor and the socialist writer of its introductory essay, reprinted from a Marxist quarterly, are temperate in tone though the book is addressed to today's radicalized youth.
